Hope for a New Type Of Polio Vaccine
As I have said before in this column, in many ways the ideal preventative for polio would be a so-called live vaccine made from living but harmless strains of virus. This would be like the vaccine against smallpox which is made from smallpox virus that has been weakened and made "safe" by passage through cows.

Polio viruses have now been so weakened by many passages through animals and eggs that they can be swallowed without danger by human beings. Already, 225 persons have received the new vaccine without accident. The great advantage of using a live virus is that the protection from polio obtained is likely to last many years or for life. The need for such long protection can be seen now, when, after 40 years, we are beginning to have epidemics of diphtheria. Such epidemics can get going in a community in which most persons have outgrown their old immunity to a particular disease.

McKay Tells Hope For Water Policy
Klamath Falls — (U.P.) — Hope that the Eisenhower administration will be able to get Congress to pass a water policy was expressed here yesterday by Douglas McKay, candidate for the Republican nomination as U. S. Senator.

In a talk before the Klamath Falls Lions club, the former interior secretary said congressional recognition of the water policy drafted by the president's national water policy committee was important to the 17 Western states.

McKay also expressed the hope that research conducted under the department of the interior will lead to cheap fresh water through de-salting sea water.

McKay said these processes already are far enough advanced so that they soon will be feasible for domestic water and may become practical within a reasonable time for industrial water. He said a great deal of remains to be done before such water can be used for irrigation at a reasonable figure.

Wilson Concedes Russia Ahead in Heavy Bombers
Washington — (U.P.) — Defense Secretary Charles E. Wilson has conceded that Russia is outstripping the United States in producing heavy bombers.

He disclosed at a news conference that the air force plans to increase the size of its B52 heavy bomber wings from 30 to 35 planes.

A recent production speed up order, he said, will mean "more planes quicker."

Stassen Sees End To Disarmament Talk

London—(U.P.)—Harold E. Stassen has predicted the current disarmament conference would come to an end because of the "directly adverse" statements made in Britain by Russia's leaders.

Stassen, U.S. delegate to the five-power United Nations sub-commission disarmament conference, said statements by Soviet Premier Nikolai Bulganin and Communist party chief Nikita S. Khrushchev had dropped chances of disarmament progress to a "low ebb." He referred to their press conference here Friday.

As a result, he said the United States, Britain, Canada, France and Russia "presumably before long" will end their current deliberations here and report back to the U.N. commission.
