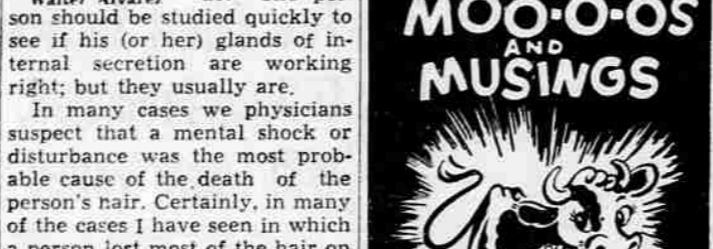

Hair Falling Out

Many persons keep asking me what to do when their hair begins to come out in handfuls. I say, "Wait and see: It soon may start coming back by itself. If it doesn't come back by itself, there usually is not much that a physician can do." The person should be studied quickly to see if his (or her) glands of internal secretion are working right; but they usually are.

In many cases we physicians suspect that a mental shock or disturbance was the most probable cause of the death of the person's hair. Certainly, in many of the cases I have seen in which a person lost most of the hair on



his (or her) body, he had had a big psychic problem to face. In a few cases, some hair came back and in other cases it did not.

Naturally, after these patients have seen many internists and skin specialists and have spent hundreds of dollars to no advantage, they ask me how about going to a quack, or an advertising person who guarantees to grow hair anywhere. All I can say is that I have heard a lot

of these people and their doings from Better Business Bureaus. The managers of these Bureaus tell me that the hair-quacks with whom they have dealt were very clever swindlers. The last letter I got from one of these managers told me how a young man, getting bald, had gone to a quack. Instead of putting any hair on his head, by clever high-pressure, the quack had induced the man to give him \$168, which was all the money he could lay his hands on. He never got any hair.

The other day I was talking to a man who all his life has been a crack salesman. He said that recently he listened to a hair-quack's "pitch," or high pressure sales-talk just for the joy of watching a master of the art at work.

Frequency of Urination

Many persons, usually elderly men, want to know why at night they have to get up every hour

or so to urinate. Usually, in such cases there is an enlargement of the prostate gland which is obstructing the neck of the bladder. As a result, when the man urinates, he does not completely empty his bladder—some urine is left, and this causes the lining-membrane of the bladder to become irritated. Also bacteria may get to growing in the stagnating urine, and this infection will cause even more irritation. If a man with this trouble puts off operation too long, some of the urine can back up into his kidneys so as to dilate them and almost destroy them.

Obviously, every elderly man who finds that he is having to exert force to urinate should soon put himself in the hands of a urologist—an expert in taking care of the bladder, the kidneys and the prostate gland. Today, usually the excess prostatic tissue is removed quickly and safely and without mortality through an electrically-lighted tube which is passed down through the urethra or the tube out of which comes the urine. This operation has the advantage of producing almost no shock; often it is done under spinal anesthesia, and usually the man is up and about the next day. I would never have one of the older types of a major operation performed on me if I could help it.

Teheran, Iran (U.P.)—Surgeons who operated on Cpl. Abol Fazl Einipour last week, after he complained of a stomach ache, said he is now 16 pounds lighter.

They removed from his stomach 24 nail clippers, 12 large penknives, four long knife blades, 13 pieces of broken glass, 19 pieces of metal chain, two shoe nails, two watch bands, two nuts and bolts, one thin metal bar, and one teaspoon.

Einipour said he was a magician for 19 years, and liked to impress his audiences by swallowing his props.

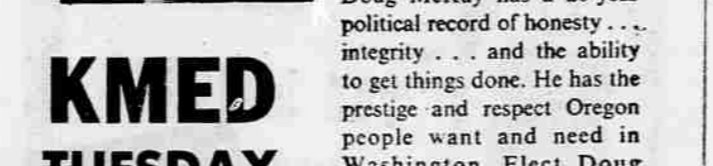
Heart Attack Takes Prominent Oregonian

Eugene (U.P.)—Angus L. Gibson, a prominent businessman in Junction City and former member of both the state House of Representatives and the state Senate, died Saturday of a heart attack.

Gibson served in the Oregon state House of Representatives from 1939 until 1943 when he moved to the upper house. He served as a senator from the joint district of Linn and Lane counties until his retirement in 1951.

Gibson celebrated his 69th birthday Friday, the same day that he was struck by the attack.
