Television Quiz Show Leads Contestant To Father, Believed Dead

New York — (U.P.) — A television program which landed a \$64,000 jackpot for a jockey also put him in touch with his father who he thought had been dead for 34 years, it was disclosed yesterday.

Billy Pearson, 36, said he would go to Kansas City to meet

his newly discovered father, Chester A. Pearson, 74, as soon as he could.

Flood of Letters

The jockey won the jackpot on the CBS television quiz program "The \$64,000 Question" by answering questions on art. His appearance on the show brought

a flood of letters as does that of most contestants on the show.

Since most of the letters are from well-wishers, salesmen and cranks, many are thrown out. However, a CBS secretary happened to open a letter from Mrs. Chester Pearson and when she read it, passed it on to the pro-

gram's master of ceremonies, Hal March.

Mrs. Pearson said her husband was certain the jockey was his son and asked March to pass the letter on to the younger Pearson.

The jockey called his mother in Pasadena, Calif., and "she told

me it was all true."

To Make Trip
He said she "let me believe that my father had died because she thought that was the best thing when she divorced him. I guess I was two or three years old at the time."

He said he then called his

father and promised to make a trip to Kansas City as soon as he could. He said his father had married again and it was the elder Pearson's second wife who wrote the letter.

"I can't say how I feel," he said. "Kind of numb I guess."

Garden Notes

One of the worst pests of narcissus bulbs is the narcissus bulb fly. In the worm stage, this pest works on the inside of the narcissus bulb and by spraying, it has either completely destroyed or severely weakened the bulb.

In late April, this worm transforms into a bee-like fly and flies around from plant to plant depositing its egg to start a generation the following year. Because of its life history, it has been a difficult pest to control, but some of the newer insecticides have given encouraging results. The best time for treating is at the time of planting, but as most growers dig their bulbs very seldom, they are interested in some form of treatment while the bulbs are in the ground.

Drenching Soil
It has been found that by drenching the soil around the plants with a solution of aldrin or heptachlor, that a new infestation can be prevented. Aldrin is available locally and it has been found that one quarter pint in three gallon of water applied to 45 feet of row is sufficient. This can be simply done by putting the material in a sprinkling can and remove the sprinkler head so it can be poured directly out of the spout.

It would be best to treat a patch of bulbs for two years in a row to be sure the infestation was cleaned up. This should maintain control for a period of years with no further applications. If any further bulbs are

Portland Card Rooms Back in Operation

Portland — (U.P.) — Portland's card rooms were back in operation yesterday after a one-day shutdown. The closure came at the request of Police Chief Jim Purcell Jr., who said he had heard reports that "embarrassing" photographs were to be taken.

The card rooms are licensed in the city strictly as non-gambling houses. The photographs that were reportedly to be taken were to show money on the tables, indicating that gambling was taking place.

Purcell said that it was conceivable that money might be on the tables at times to pay for refreshments but said that the parlors are licensed solely as non-gambling entertainment places.

Purcell said he has no power to order the parlors to close unless there is evidence of illegal activity taking place. He advised the operators of the establishments of the photograph report before they reopened their doors yesterday.

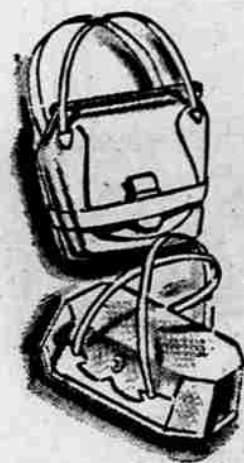
