Museum Has 2,786 Visitors in April

Jacksonville — A total of 2,786 visitors toured the Jacksonville Museum during April, according to the Jacksonville Museum monthly report.

Visitors came from 24 states and Alaska, Canada, Panama, and New Zealand.
 Students from area high schools and junior high schools comprised the biggest share of visitors. Schools visiting the museum have been Grants Pass Junior High school, Jackson school, Howard school, Tri-City schools, Roosevelt school, and Walker school of Ashland.
 Among new exhibits at the museum are three Navajo rugs, a white hand embroidered linen dress, two Indian stoles used for chipping wood and shaping moccasins, an Indian war club, and an old neck yoke.
