Sugar Ray To Try for Quick Kayo

San Jacinto, Calif. — (U.P.) — Sugar Ray Robinson, finished training and favored at 13-10, will try for another quick knock-out over Carl Bobo Olson Friday night in their middleweight title bout, he said Wednesday.

"I'll try to set him up for a kayo just as soon as possible," explained the 35-year-old champion who recaptured the 160-pound crowd for the second time last Dec. 9, on a knock-out over Olson in the second round at Chicago.

Sitting in the living room of his training cottage, the slender New Yorker added, "I feel sharper and much more confident than before the Chicago fight." He completed eleven weeks of training with two final rounds of sparring Tuesday here at Willie Orner's camp.

Ray said he expects to scale 159½ pounds for the fight at Wrigley Field, Los Angeles, at 10 p.m. EDT Friday. That will be practically the same figure forecast by 27-year-old Olson, who did his last boxing on Monday at Santa Monica, Calif.

Robinson and his entourage of 19, will break camp Thursday and motor the eighty miles into Los Angeles. Sugar Ray will go into seclusion at the home of friends in the suburbs while the rest of his party stays at the Hotel Watkins.
