

# Princess Margaret May Marry Dashing German, Paper Says

London—(U.P.)—Lord Beaverbrook's Daily Express said today there were new "rumors" that Princess Margaret may marry a dashing German prince who once captured two purse-snatchers in New York's Central Park.

Buckingham Palace refused immediate comment on the reports.

The prince is 35-year-old Christian of Hanover who was a cavalry officer in a German regiment that fought the Russians during World War II. He is a distant cousin of the princess and a great-great-grandson of Queen Victoria.

Princess Christian also is a brother of Queen Frederika of

Greece and a brother of the Duke of Brunswick who won a long legal battle last year to be recognized as a British subject. Both the prince and the duke were brought up in Germany.

The prince left Germany after the war for the United States but now works as director of a shipping company in London. Two years ago in New York he captured two thieves in Central Park. He was riding in a taxi when he saw two thugs snatch a woman's purse. He leaped out, felled both with a flying tackle and pinned one to the ground. The caddy called a policeman to arrest the other.

The princess has been entertained by the prince and he has been a guest at Windsor Castle. But they seldom have been seen together in public and he has not taken an active part in London's social life.

The Express said he told a reporter Monday "I can neither confirm nor deny" the reports of an engagement. The Express said it had received hundreds of telephone calls asking if the story were really true.

American newspapers printed rumors of a romance last November after Group Captain Peter Townsend returned dejectedly to Brussels when Princess Margaret decided she could not marry him. The reports were recently revived in Greece and Germany.

Ethne Chesterman of Brooklyn named five Roman emperors in order of their succession to win \$8000 and a chance for the \$16,000 question next week.

Mrs. Bobbye O'Rourke, 24, the Ohio housewife, won her \$8000 by answering questions on Sherlock Holmes.

## Russia Challenged On Press Freedom

Moscow—(U.P.)—French Premier Guy Mollet challenged the Soviet Union today to permit greater freedom of the press and travel "without concern for propaganda" to bring about greater East-West friendliness.

Mollet made his appeal in a lunch speech following a morning session with Soviet Premier Nikolai Bulganin and Communist party secretary, Nikita Khrushchev, at the start of their "little summit" conference.

Officials said after the opening talks, which were a further effort to lessen East-West tension, that there had been "a frank exchange of opinions" on disarmament.

In his lunch speech, Mollet said that "the press, radio, cinema and travel" are the best means to bring the East and West together.

## Examinations Set For Children Who Will Enter School

Children who expect to enter school next fall should be examined by a physician so the child may have an opportunity to have correctable physical defects corrected before starting school, according to Medford city school nurses, Olive Curry and DeLores Rabjohn.

They pointed out it is best to have family physicians conduct examinations because equipment is available in an office for a thorough examination and the physician is more familiar with the child.

The Medford school will have a physician and other professional personnel in various schools next week for the annual summer round up, they said. The sessions are for those who find it inconvenient to visit family physicians, the nurses said.

The schedule for school visits include Jefferson school, Monday, May 21; Washington school, Tuesday, May 22; Roosevelt school, Wednesday, May 23; Jackson school, Thursday, May 24; and Lincoln school, Friday, May 25. Clinics will be open between 9:30 and 11 a.m. each day, and parents are urged to bring children as soon after 9:30 a.m. as possible.

The nurses reminded parents to fill out the Oregon Pupil Medical record form at home and take it when the child has the examination, either by a family physician or at the school.
