

Negroes Observe Desegregation; 'Black Monday' Meeting Slated

Negroes across the nation observed the second anniversary of the historic Supreme Court school desegregation ruling today with solemn fasting and prayer.

White persons were expected to join Negroes in the churches of many cities with prayers of Thanksgiving. The governors and mayors of some northern cities and states issued proclamations giving the observances official backing.

But in the Deep South, where most states are yet to start complying with the Supreme Court ruling to end segregation in public schools, observances of another kind were planned.

Members of the pro-segregation White Citizens councils said they would hold "Black Monday" meetings, commemorating the Monday in 1954 when Chief Justice Earl Warren handed down the school ruling.

The Alabama Citizens council scheduled a "Black Monday" meeting at Birmingham, with Circuit Judge Tom Brady, credited with originating the term, billed as main speaker. Georgia's Gov. Marvin Griffin was to address a council meeting at New Orleans, although it was not announced as an anniversary observance.

The nationwide day of fasting and prayer is sponsored by the National Baptist convention. Its president, Dr. Joseph H. Jackson, told the United Press in Chicago that close to 100,000,000 persons, white and Negro,

would take part in some way in at least 21 states.

The observances in northern cities such as Chicago took the form of mass meetings and church ceremonies. In the South Jackson said, they will be on a "subdued basis."

Those who devote the whole day to the anniversary obser-

vance will fast from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., Jackson said. Then they will attend prayer services.

Jackson, who is pastor of Chicago's Olivet Baptist church said

he expects observances in Illinois, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, Mississippi, Texas, Oklahoma, Georgia, Tennessee, Alabama, Calif-

ornia, Michigan, Ohio, Minnesota, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Kansas, Missouri, Florida, Louisiana, and the District of Columbia.

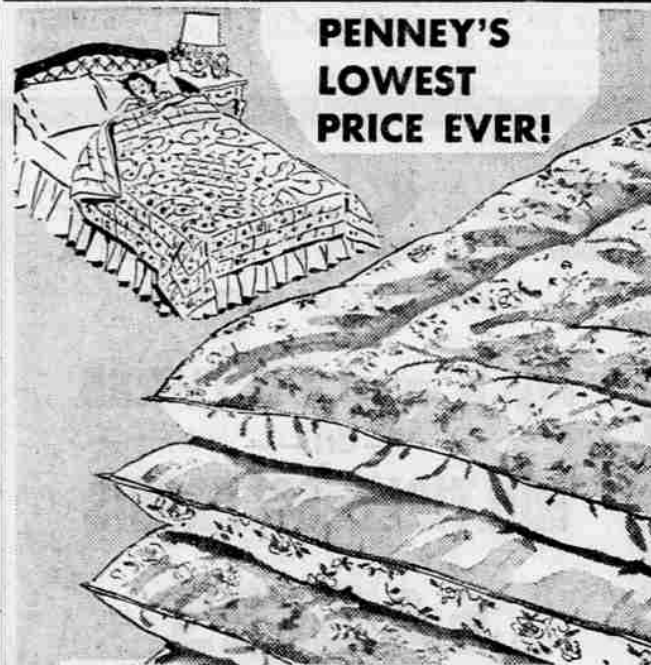

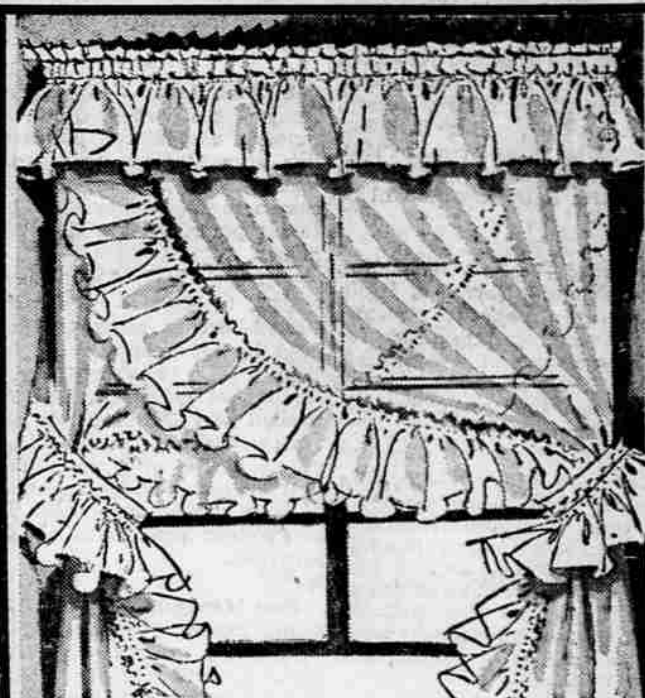

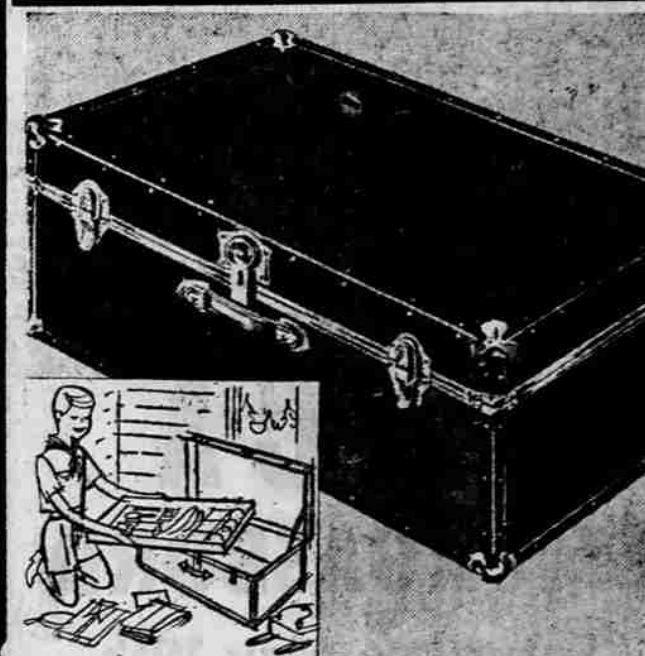

Weather Again Delays Nuclear Air Drop

Aboard USS Mt. McKinley—(U.P.)—Unfavorable weather conditions forced the United States again today to postpone for two days the long delayed hydrogen bomb air drop, the first this country has attempted.

Test officials called off the shot just 41 minutes before the scheduled drop time. They said they would try again Saturday (U.S. time).

According to the prearranged schedule, the B52 bomber carrying the lethal nuclear weapon would have been making its preliminary runs over the target when the postponement was announced.

It was the second straight day the test was called off virtually at the last minute.
