

Sen. Wayne Morse Calls for Chromite Incentive Program

Washington, D.C.—(Special)—Sen. Wayne Morse (D-Ore.) has called for extension of an incentive program for chromite production to maintain operations in southwestern Oregon and northern California.

Senators Morse and Richard L. Neuberger have introduced legislation to extend until 1961 the chromite purchase program under which the government depot at Grants Pass is operated. It is scheduled to terminate at the end of June, 1957, under present law.

Committee Statement

In a statement to a Senate Interior subcommittee in support of their bill, Senator Morse emphasized the economic importance of chromite production in southwestern Oregon and particularly in Josephine county. From a 1951 estimate of \$62,972, the value of the chromite industry in Oregon rose to \$536,387 in 1954 and \$400,000 in 1955, with Josephine county accounting for 90 per cent of the value of production.

"Thus," he said, "an interruption in the incentive program for chromite would have a serious adverse effect upon this area. Much the same situation would exist in northern California. I might add that of the 200,000 long tons of chromite the depot is authorized to purchase, only 93,985 long tons had been bought at the end of September, 1955."

Dulles Aids Reds, Harriman Charges

Salt Lake City — (U.P.) — New York Gov. Averell Harriman brought his "inactive" campaign for the Democratic presidential nomination to Utah today with a charge that Secretary of State John Foster Dulles "at times" is aiding the cause of the Kremlin.

In an address prepared for delivery to a Salt Lake City luncheon, Harriman asserted that the Republican secretary of state "at times seems to be posing for the very picture the Kremlin is trying to paint of the United States, as militarists and supporters of colonialism."

"Half the people of the free world have just emerged from colonial status," Harriman said. "These people are jealous of their political independence and eager for economic advancement. In the past they have always looked to the United States as champions of their aspirations and they should be able to now."

"But instead of paying attention to the aspirations of these newly independent nations, Secretary Dulles flies around the world negotiating military alliances which are worthless unless they are accompanied by economic and social progress."

23rd College Joins In Five-Year Plan

Chicago — (U.P.) — St. Joseph's college of Collegeville, Ind., has become the 23rd liberal arts college to join with Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, in a five-year plan to provide students with a liberal arts and engineering education.

"The combined program is designed to help meet the need for trained engineers with broadened educational backgrounds," according to Dr. John Day Larkin, head of the program at Illinois Tech.

The combined program will go into effect at St. Joseph's college next September.

Under the program a student follows a liberal arts course at St. Joseph's, or one of the eight engineering fields for two years.

After the fifth year the student receives a bachelor of arts of science degree from the liberal arts college and an engineering degree from Illinois Tech.
