Public Interest in Science On rare occasions I find an article on science designed to be read by laymen: An article which dispenses because the writer was evidently talking down to his audience. He was wise, cracking and trying to be earnest, intelligent persons who would want information and would want it in a serious form. They would expect it to be authentic, up-to-date, and couched in simple English speech.

I thought of this today as I read in Science a report of a study recently made by members of the faculty of the University of Michigan. They questioned 200 persons and found that three in four liked to read the science news in their local newspaper. One in four said they read every scrap of science information they could find. One in three said they wished the papers would publish more material on science. Interestingly some said that in order to get more on science they would be willing to give up space on sports and society news! Perhaps the women wanted less on sport and the men wanted less on what Mrs. So-and-so wore to the Van Trons ball!

What is curious is that three out of the 200 interviewed had not heard of the Salk vaccine! But what is very hopeful is that 97 knew about Salk and his work.

quinine: An extract of the bark of a tree known for centuries to the Indians of Peru. The local medicine men used it, and the Spaniards, on learning about it from them, introduced it to the world. In World War II, when quinine became unavailable to the Allies, a synthetic drug had to be found—that is, one constructed by chemists. Several were tried, and then it was found that one of them—quinacrine—was even better than quinine. Later, came chloroquine which, according to the writers of the book, was better and safer than the quinacrine. Then British chemists found Prognanil, which, curiously, was a chemical very different from quinine.
