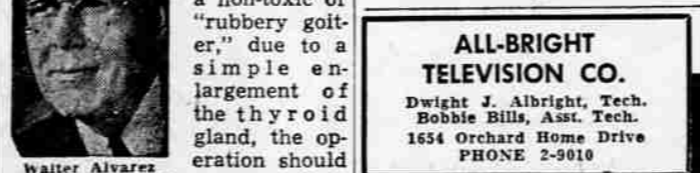
Galasheff was west bound at the time of the accident, police reported. He had been employed by the Corps of Engineers for more than 20 years.

What Happens After Operation On Thyroid Gland?

Many persons who are facing an operation for goiter want to know what they should expect after surgery. If they have only a non-toxic or "rubbery goiter," due to a simple enlargement of the thyroid gland, the operation should leave them feeling very well. It will make them look better, and it will remove from them the danger of cancer. Persons with a very toxic and perhaps exophthalmic type of goiter (with prominent eyes) should feel immensely better with the removal of the toxin-producing gland. Sometimes the surgeon is a bit off on his estimate of how much of the gland should be left; he takes out a bit too much, and hence after the operation, the person soon shows signs of having too little thyroid substance. The woman may feel cold and sleepy and slowed-up. In such case, she will probably have to take some thyroid substance for the rest of her days.

Family Council

Ruth—My sister puts all the burden on me.

Clara—I'm crowded out of the family.

Ruth—My sister, Clara, is proving a terrible trial to my parents and to me, and I can't understand her at all. I see her in school, where I am in the senior class and she is a sophomore, and she is the model of courtesy, agreeableness and good behavior. But at home, she is a terror. No one dares ask her to do anything, and if she does descend to help in the household, she invariably does some damage.

My mother is often in tears over this problem, and my father is always blaming mother for not having raised her right. I feel that I should be an unfair burden. With my mother often being upset and Clara either refusing to help or doing things in a poor way, I have to shoulder most of the housework.

Clara manages to have a lot of dates and spends most of her time away from home. But I am stuck home and seldom can go out. I never have a date, and it seems I am never expected to. I'd like to get away from it by going to college out of town, but I am afraid that if I am not home, Clara and my parents will never get along at all.

Clara—I would like to help at home, but I cannot endure the fault-finding. Ruth simply does those things better than I, but I do not see why I should always be ragged and compared to my disadvantage. When I was little, I was not expected to do any of these things, and now I am expected to know without having learned. I can't wait until I am old enough to get away from this place, but I am terribly afraid of having to be at home alone with my parents. I do not feel that I will be able to stand up to it if I am required to do a lot of housework to the accompaniment of constant sharp criticism.

The Council: Ruth notes that her sister Clara is "a model of courtesy, agreeableness and good behavior" at school, while at home she is "a terror." This states the problem very well, and at the same time suggests its cause and solution.

In school, Clara is desirous of establishing and maintaining a good reputation so that she will be accepted and looked up to; at home Clara must feel that she already damned by reputation and therefore in a hopeless position.

Comparison is an odious process, and it has been painfully so to Clara. As the younger of two sisters, she was naturally less skillful in household duties. The parents might have avoided comparisons that would wound the sensibilities of the younger child, and might have trained her in some little specialty of household work so that her pride would be appeased. They evidently were unmindful of this problem and it has grown.

Ruth could do a great deal during the coming months to ease this tension and prepare Clara to adjust herself to her home next year, when she will be alone with her parents. Ruth has an opportunity not only to prepare Clara for the future, but to establish a closer relationship with her. In the process, Ruth would also be gaining a little more freedom for herself.

Ruth should make a direct approach to Clara, explaining the fact that circumstances had tended to crowd Clara out of things at home and offering to help train her in some household arts. She must dispel any notions of stigma or disfavor attaching to Clara, and put the whole situation on a rational basis.

Lamkin Sentencing Delayed Until June 4

Salem — (U.P.) — Circuit Judge Frank Loneragan said yesterday that sentencing of Salem attorney Walter S. Lamkin would be delayed until June 4.

Lamkin pleaded guilty May 7 to embezzlement of a client's funds. He was to have been sentenced today.

Chicago — (U.P.) — A Chicago widow left nearly \$500,000 for the care of stray animals it was revealed Monday. The will of Mrs. Alice Bourke who died May 3 divides the money equally between the Illinois Citizens Animal Welfare League and the Anti-Cruelty Society.

Eden Takes Action In Case of Frogman

London — (U.P.) — A London newspaper has reported that Prime Minister Anthony Eden took "disciplinary action" in the case of the missing frogman by punishing three intelligence officers.

The Daily Express said Eden ordered over the week-end that the junior officers be transferred to other units.

With their departure, the Express said, the case of the frogman, Cmdr. Lionel (Buster) Crabb, is officially considered closed. The newspaper added the mystery may never be explained to the public.

Crabb vanished last April 19, apparently while swimming beneath Russian warships that brought Soviet leaders Nikolai Bulganin and Nikita S. Khrushchev to Britain.

The famous frogman's body never has been found and Eden has refused to disclose any details of his disappearance other than to promise disciplinary action would be taken.
