New York — (U.P.) — Gene Fullmer, 24, outstanding American contender for the middleweight crown, declared angrily today, "I'll demand the next title shot if I beat Charley Humez Friday night." The bull-necked mining welder from West Jordan, Utah, added, "and I'll have the backing of a millionaire to force the shot if Sugar Ray Robinson tries to defend against Carmen Basilio." Fullmer emphasized that his outburst at Stillman's gymnasium did not mean he was taking a victory for granted over Humez of France at Madison Square Garden Friday night. "Clear The Air "But I want to clear the air before we get into the ring," he explained. "When Humez and I accepted this match, it was with the understanding that the winner would get the next title shot. I've got a lot of respect for Humez. I expect a hard fight, but I expect to win, and get the title fight I was promised." Humez is rated No. 1 among the world's contenders; Fullmer No. 2. But the betting was at "even money" today. ## Pat Flaherty In Pole Spot For Big Race

Indianapolis, Ind. — (U.P.) — Pat Flaherty, a happy-go-lucky Irishman, just wanted to make sure he will fit into the front row when the bomb sends 33 high-powered cars into the auto race on Memorial Day. The 30-year-old Chicagoan wound up with more than that—he'll be leading the rolling roadsters, by virtue of winning the pole position with the record average of 145.596 miles an hour last Saturday. Flaherty thus becomes one of the leading choices to pick up the rich jackpot at the payoff banquet the night following the race, and the experts figured it was about time, too, that his racing luck changes. Only once before did he receive the checkered flag of victory in a major event. That was the 250-miler at Milwaukee last summer. Ten years ago this freckle-faced youngster had no ambitions to get mixed up in this hazardous profession. He was a mechanic by trade but caught the racing bug while working for one of the speed merchants. Rest Was Easy The rest was easy. He started with jalopies, then graduated to midgets, sprints, finally winding up with big cars. He took his "500" driving test in 1949 and finished tenth in his first start the next year. Flaherty had his share of troubles. In 1953 he suffered a concussion while hitting the northeast wall. The following year he tangled with Jimmy Daywalt in a spectacular wreck and again glanced off the wall. Last year he drove the distance with bad shocks and again finished 10th. So this year he wants everything to go correctly. He drove about 300 miles practice, then hurled his new white-and-pink racer around the oval for new records. and his handlers were considering a defense against Basilio of Chittenango, N.Y., ex-welterweight champion.
