Debra now is the world's only actress who can take her car to a jeweler for a \$5,000 mile checkup and oil change.

She is the owner of a special strawberry-colored sedan encrusted with hundreds of fake gems.

The pink and crystal "jewels" are glued on the bumpers, the chrome and hood ornament on the front of the car and over the entire top in a sunburst design. Inside the dashboard is upholstered in gold leather and besprinkled with more glittering baubles. The steering wheel, clock and instruments also are sparkling with the phony jewels.

Effect Described

The whole effect is like one of those jewel-covered ladies' plastic handbags on wheels.

Every time Debra ventures out on the streets of Los Angeles in this vehicle, traffic comes to an astonished standstill. The other day she drove onto the Paramount lot and the entire studio, from secretaries to stars, quit work for a look. One member of the awe-struck crowd observed, "Jayne Mansfield could walk by now with no clothes on and nobody would notice."

The shapely Miss Paget explained she had the auto decorated to match her bouidoir.

"I had it painted strawberry just like the velvet bedspread and drapes in my bedroom, and then added jewels like I have on handbags," she said.

"I don't believe in this business of actresses staying in the kitchen and wearing aprons. Hollywood is known as a glamorous spot but people usually are so disappointed when they see film stars."

Debra has blossomed out as one of the more colorful film-villainesses. She has a two-year-old gibbon ape as a pet in her home, the former abode of glamorous Constance Bennett. She started wearing three-inch long earrings before they became a general fad. And she claims to have been the first owner of an orchid-colored Cadillac.

"I had that car painted orchid four years ago to match a dress," she said. "People stared and some thought it looked horrible. But now I notice automobile manufacturers are coming out with orchid cars. There are so many, in fact, that I sold mine and decided to start a new fashion."

Debra bought \$350 worth of phony gems. She and her mother glued on the design "and it took 20 hours of hard work."

The glue is supposed to be waterproof so the effect won't vanish during an 89-cent wash job.

I am told that for 25 cents, sent to the Public Affairs Committee, 22 East 38th St., New York City, one can get a booklet which tells all about summer camps, what they are like, and what parents should look for in choosing one. What sort of a program is planned for the children? Is the program devised for a particular type of child, or for children in general? Is there a good director, and are there enough well-trained and sensible counselors? Is the food good, and is there adequate medical supervision? Are the housing facilities adequate? Is the camp usually a happy place, and are the costs reasonable enough for the family purse?

Marketing Problems Discussed on Trip

Salem—Marketing problems of fruit and specialty crop groups were discussed with Paul T. Rowell, market development chief for the state department of agriculture, during a recent trip to southern Oregon.

In addition to the large production of pears in the Medford-Ashland area, moderate tonnages of Hale peaches are also grown there and shipped to California markets. Peach growers principal problem is maintaining stable markets during peak harvest periods, Rowell found.

Rowell found the Easter lily marketing situation in fair shape. Most of the U.S. production is in Oregon and Del Norte county, Calif. Prices are considerably lower, but fairly satisfactory to efficient growers who produce quality bulbs.

Gladiolus bulb acreage in the Grants Pass area has decreased about one-third in the past few years, Rowell was told. Growers said Dutch imports grown under lower labor costs are capturing much of the U. S. markets. Only 10 to 15 per cent of the U. S. gladiolus industry is in the Pacific coast states, principally Oregon.

The annual harvest of fish from Minnesota lakes and streams average 80 pounds per acre. The total fish catch is about 20 million pounds.
