'Hurricane Sam' To Test Ways To Improve Survival

Hurricane, Utah—(U.P.)—"Hurricane Sam," an instrument stuffed dummy, will ride a rocket propelled sled to the edge of a Utah mesa Friday, then hurtle into space in America's latest test of ways to improve survival chances in supersonic aircraft bailouts.

Sam will take his ride on "Smart," the \$2,000,000 supersonic military air research track on Hurricane Mesa, midway between here and Zion National park.

37 Experiments
The track has been the scene of 37 experiments since it was completed last fall. But until run No. 38 Friday, only military and civilian staff members of the Air Research and Development Center have been allowed to watch the show.

The 12,000 foot long, mirror-level track through a clearing on the mesa is designed to accommodate a rocket driven sled at speeds of up to 15,000 miles an hour.

Capsule Ejected
When the sled reaches the sharp south end of the mesa, the rocket unit halts abruptly when a scoop catches in a water trough. A capsule on the carriage is ejected, as though from a warplane, and lowered 1,500 feet to the Virgin River Valley floor by parachute.

Unlike the slower track at Alamogordo, N.M., where Lt. Col. John P. Stapp rode a sled at 632 miles an hour in December, 1954, "Smart" is not designed to carry a human cargo.

Sam and his instruments are the only occupants. In previous "closed" tests, Sam has ridden "Smart" at up to 930 miles an hour.

Albany To Eugene Expressway Aired

Albany — (U.P.) — The State Highway commission held a hearing yesterday on a proposed new expressway route to lead from Albany to Eugene. No objections to the proposed plans were voiced at yesterday's hearings.

The proposed expressway would run nearly in a direct line from Albany to Eugene and would bypass the towns now located on highway 99E.

The proposal calls for the highway to junction off from the present 99E highway at the present Jefferson junction north of here and to bypass Halsey, Shedd, Harrisburg, Junction City, Albany and Eugene. The highway would junction with the present 99E between Eugene and Springfield.

W. C. Williams, deputy highway engineer, said that the highway commission hoped to have the new route under construction within the next three years.

Seattle Man To Be New Manager of KGW

Portland — (U.P.) — Radio station KGW's new manager will be John H. Eichhorn. The Pioneer Broadcasting company, owner of the station, said he would succeed James Mount, whose resignation, announced last week, becomes effective May 31.

Eichhorn has been commercial manager and station manager of KING radio in Seattle the past several years.
