ADVERTISING ON INCREASE

Chicago — (U.P.) — Advertising Age, trade magazine, said Saturday that national newspaper advertising showed a 17 per cent increase last year over the 1954 figure. It said a record \$695 million was billed in 1955 compared with \$594,100,000 the previous year.
