Psoriasis

Thousands of persons want to know what psoriasis is and what to do for it. Psoriasis is a chronic, hereditary disease in which the lesions tend to come and go throughout a lifetime. Fortunately, in most cases, the disease is not serious, and the lesions appear only around the elbows and knees and perhaps on the scalp. In bad cases the patches of red skin with fine silvery scales will spread all over the body. In some cases the disease

attacks the skin on the sides of the fingernails and toenails, and in severe cases the patient suffers from an arthritis which is related to the psoriasis. The lesions of psoriasis may spread more widely over the body when the person is mentally upset over something; later, they may recede markedly even when the person has not had any treatment.

Usually a good skin specialist can help with scales and ultraviolet rays. What is said is that oftentimes the skin specialist uses every known drug and form of treatment, and yet, for a time, the disease refuses to let up.
