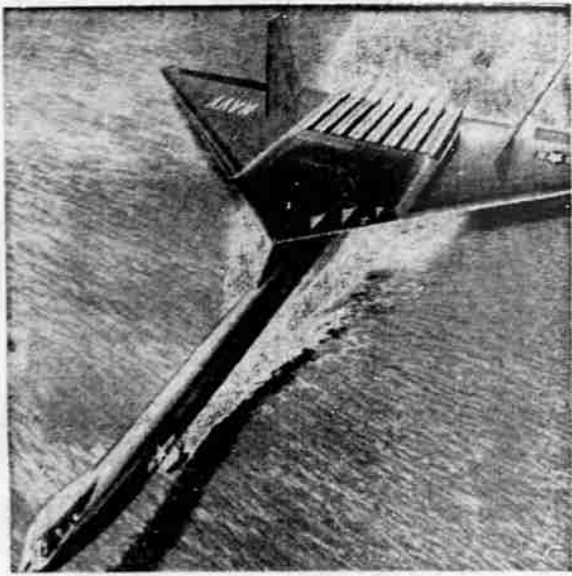

Five Rebel Groups Trapped by French

Aigiers—(U.P.)—Two French divisions snapped shut a deadly trap Saturday on five Algerian rebel groups under turbaned General Si Amrouche, killing nearly 300. French authorities called it "the biggest battle of the year." They said French troops also captured more than 150 in three days of fighting in the wild, rocky Kabylie mountains, 35 miles south of Bougie.

The rebels under self-styled General Si Amrouche were said to be regrouping, apparently for a desperate attempt to break out of the triangle trap near Lafayette.

For four months the rebels ruled the area between Akbou in the north, Bordj Bou Arreridj in the south and Lafayette in the east.

French troops drove toward the center of the craggy, cave-studded area Saturday. They used knives, bayonets and gun butts in scattered close fighting.

THIEVES STEAL TRAIN

Detroit—(U.P.)—A stolen railroad engine with a string of nine freight cars went charging about the city Sunday with railroad patrolmen and regular police in hot but fruitless pursuit. The train was recaptured when the thieves returned it to the yard from which it was stolen and then fled. They were not captured. Railroad officials said the thieves took the train flawlessly through dozens of complicated switch systems and picked up and deposited cars like experts.
