The Medical Roundup

Many persons ask what they should do about insomnia. I ought to be an expert on this because I have suffered from insomnia ever since by influence in 1918. For a year and more after that it seemed as if I would never learn to sleep again. Because I had to work hard every day to do my job at the University and to earn my living in my office, for some time I just had to take a sleeping tablet every night. Without it I could not have kept going. Medical friends said, "Wait; do nothing, and eventually, out of sheer fatigue, you will start sleeping again." The difficulty was that with great responsibilities weighing on me, I could not stop long enough to try such an experiment. I was in much the situation of a concert pianist who goes from city to city giving recitals. After each evening concert he is so lit-up

that he cannot possibly quiet down and sleep until perhaps 2 or 3 in the morning. But if he gets only a few hours' sleep, he'll be a nervous wreck next day. How, then, is he to practice all morning and then give a good performance at night? As in my case, the only solution may be to take a pill. Civilized life for some of us is so strenuous and demanding and stirring that at night the brain hasn't time in which to quiet down. As I say of myself, at night I cannot shut off the machinery. I may not have anything to worry about, and I may succeed fairly well in shutting off my stream of thought, but still I may lie quiet for an hour without the coming of sleep.

Many persons have written to disagree with me for saying that some persons should take sleeping-pills. There are many persons—and even some doctors—who say that barbiturates are as bad as morphine, but this of course, is utterly ridiculous. I have, of course, seen a few persons who became addicted to barbiturates, but in my long
