than a 65 per cent likelihood of his explanation for having lived, bearing a child who can survive. Her non-diabetic sister has an 86.5 per cent chance of bearing a living child.

Another problem that faces the diabetic mother is that her baby has three times the usual chance of having some congenital malformation. Before the coming of insulin, women suffering from severe diabetes rarely became pregnant, and when they did so, in half of the cases either the mother or the child failed to survive.
