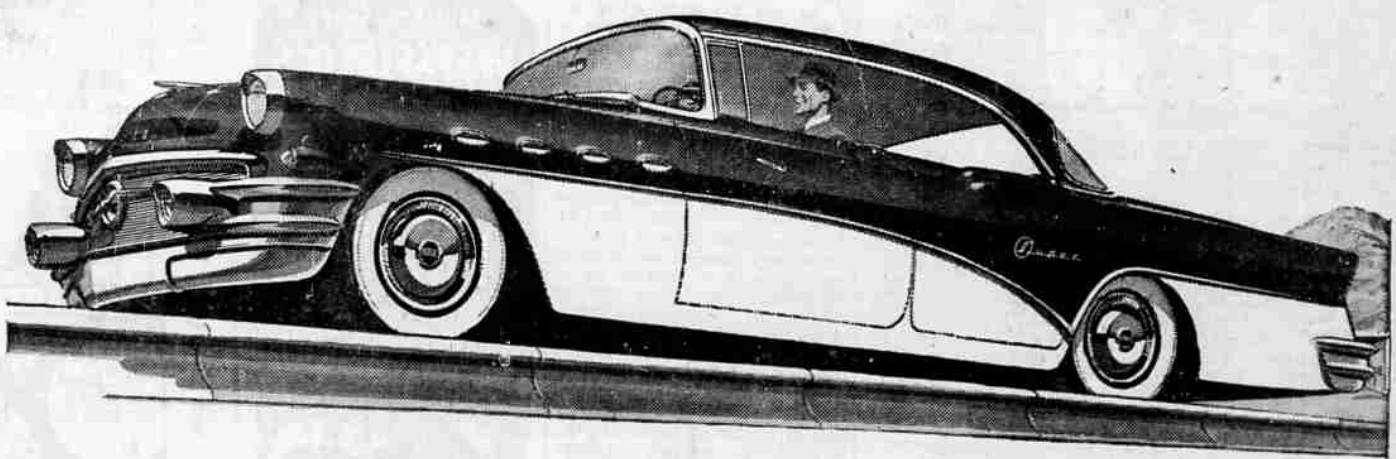
Radioactive Food May Solve Iron Deficiency
