

# Demos From Several States Hold Key for Stevenson on 2nd Ballot

Washington — (U.P.) — Democratic national convention delegates from about a dozen states hold the key to whether Adlai E. Stevenson can try to win the presidential nomination on the second ballot.

Some of these states are known reservoirs of Stevenson strength, but the course to be followed by others is still uncertain. Perhaps the biggest

enigma is Texas' 56-vote delegation, which — if thrown to Stevenson at a critical time — could start a stampede.

Some Stevenson supporters are talking of trying for a first ballot victory, but the prevailing viewpoint now is that the big push will come on the second or third ballots.

**Texas Pledged To Johnson**  
Texas is pledged to vote for

Senate Democratic Leader Lyndon B. Johnson, a favorite-son candidate, as long as his name is before the convention. Five other states have "favorite son" candidates and with Texas they will cast a total of 248 votes of the 1,372 at the convention.

Stevenson forces are confident of picking up a substantial majority on the second ballot from the delegations of two of

these states. They are Massachusetts, which expects to give 40 first ballot votes to House Democratic Leader John W. McCormack, and New Mexico, which plans 16 first ballot votes for Sen. Clinton P. Anderson.

Second in importance to Texas is the 54-vote Ohio delegation pledged to Gov. Frank J. Lausche. The word from Ohio is that a majority of these dele-

gates want to jump to Stevenson as soon as they have fulfilled their favorite-son obligations to Lausche.

Other favorite son states are Michigan, with 44 votes committed to Gov. G. Mennen Williams; and Missouri, with 38 for Sen. Stuart Symington, who may become a major dark horse contender if the Stevenson campaign collapses. In Kentucky,

which has 32 convention votes, Gov. A. B. (Happy) Chandler hopes to be a favorite son candidate.

A United Press tabulation of first ballot strength for the three active Democratic candidates now gives Stevenson 368½ votes, Sen. Estes Kefauver of Tennessee 163 and Gov. Averell Harriman of New York 137. However, the Stevenson or-

ganization now claims 502 of the 686½ needed to nominate and Harriman's managers claim 190. While the Stevenson claim was not in the form of a state-by-state breakdown, it was said to exclude some fairly sure Stevenson strength. For example, it did not include New Jersey, where Stevenson now appears to have a majority of the 36-vote delegation for an early ballot, possibly the first.
