Plans for Woodburn Base to Go Ahead

Washington — (U.P.) — Rep. Walter Norblad (R-Ore.), said Saturday that plans for an Air Force-Navy air base in the Woodburn, Ore., area would go ahead as scheduled.

The Air Force received a \$14 million authorization from Congress but asked only for an appropriation of \$2,400,000 for the next fiscal year.

Norblad explained that the difference between the two figures was due to the fact that the Air Force would be unable to spend more than the appropriation request in a single year.

Norblad said that within the next week or two, after legislation becomes effective, Army Engineers would begin to acquire land and start design and planning work for the base that would replace the Portland air base. He said construction would begin the next fiscal year.

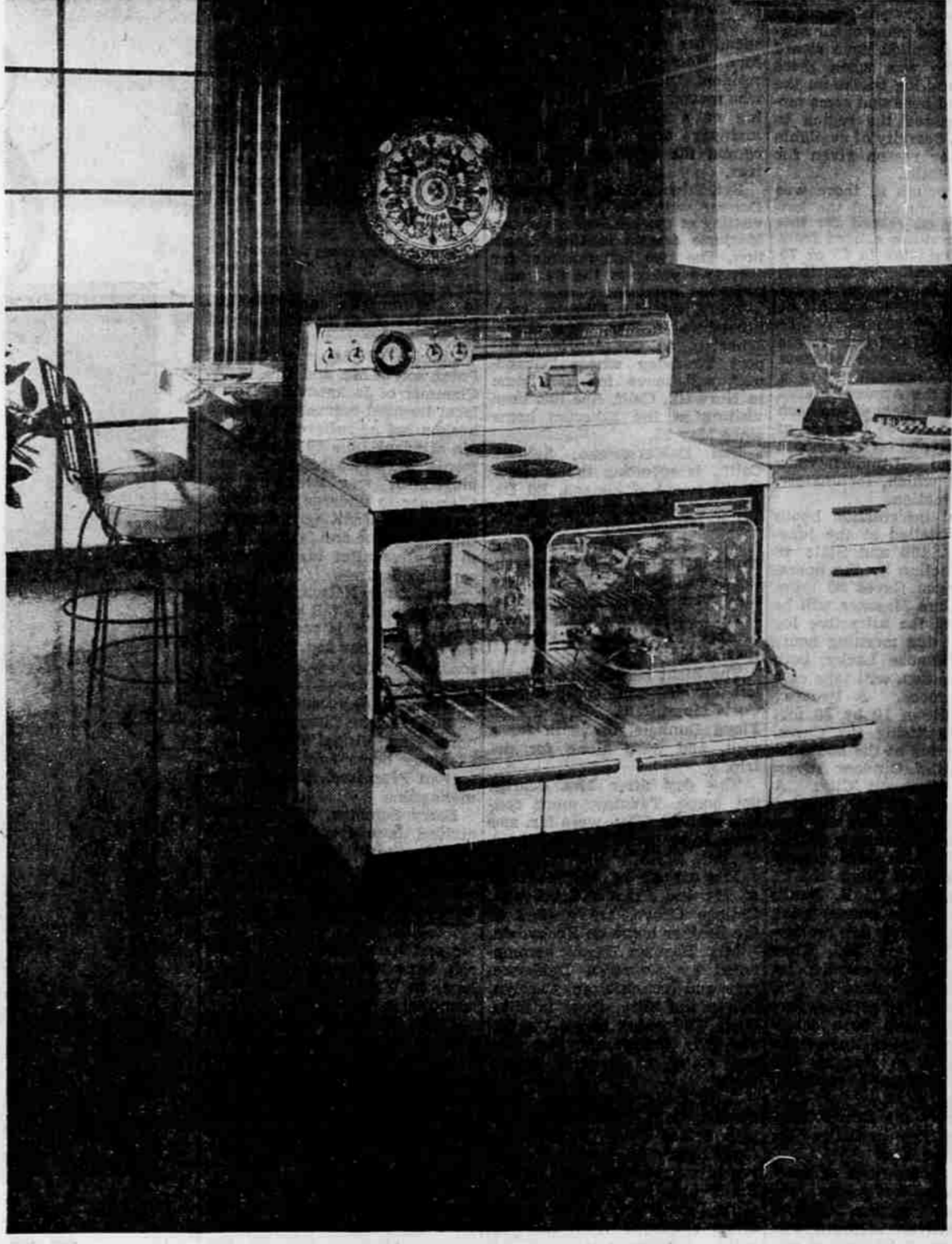
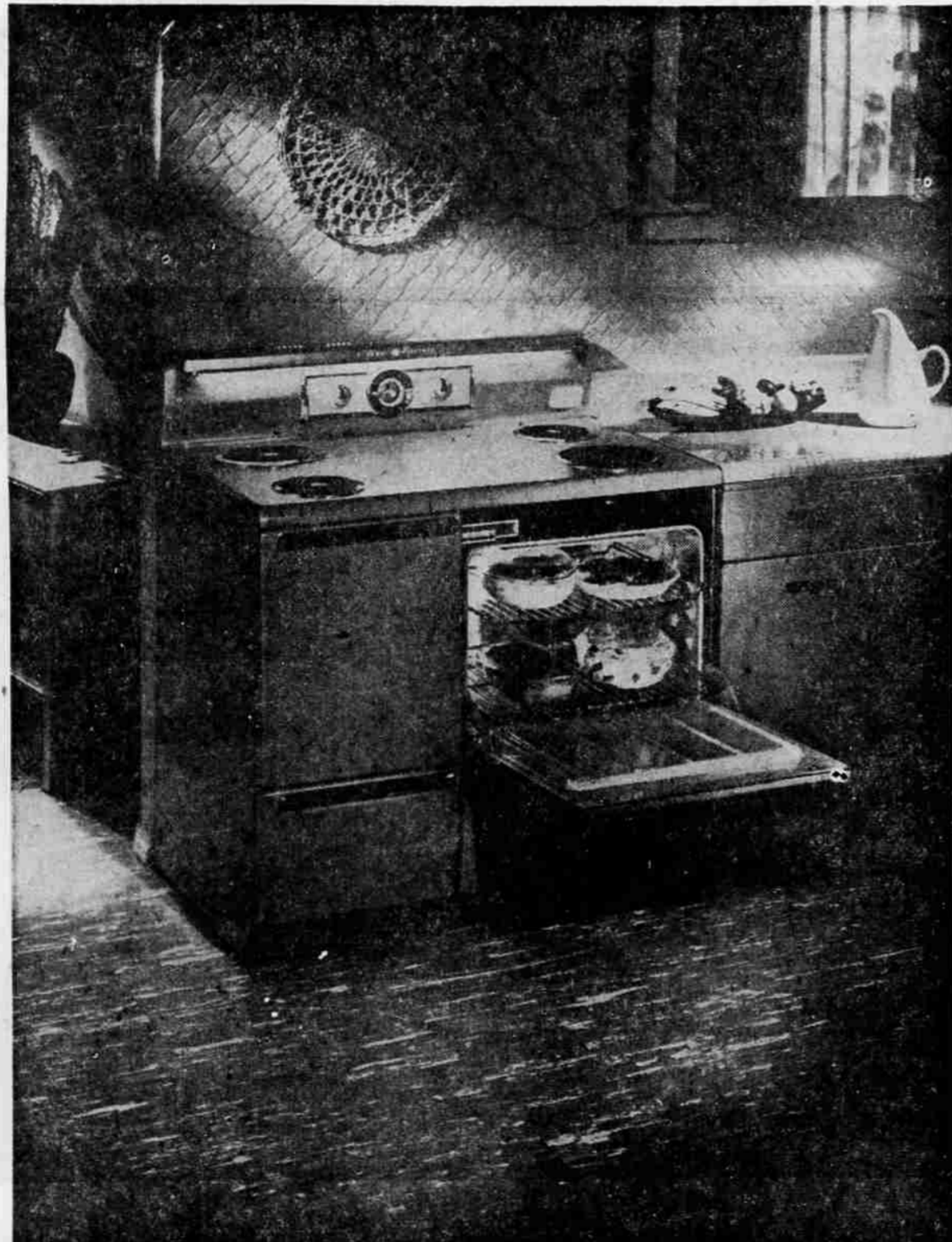
