

Hells Canyon Vote Pleases IPC Head

Washington — (AP) — T. E. Roach, president of the Idaho Power company, said today he was pleased "naturally" at the Senate vote defeating authorization of a federal dam in Hells Canyon.

The company has started construction on a plan for three smaller dams in the canyon under licenses issued last year by the Federal Power Commission.

"Naturally," Roach said, "I'm pleased to see the Senate uphold the findings of the Federal Power Commission and prove again to the people of the country that there is in the Congress an abiding conviction that private enterprise can carry on any project of this character, no matter what its size may be."

"With this endorsement of the findings of the Federal Power Commission we will continue to push development of the project to early completion for the benefit of the people of Idaho and the entire Pacific Northwest."

Surgery on Siamese Twins Successful

San Diego, Calif. — (AP) — Siamese twins Larry and Gary Hutchens, born July 2, both were reported in excellent condition today after being separated by a team of surgeons.

The infants, sons of Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Hutchens of El Cajon, underwent 94 minutes of surgery Thursday. They are expected to be released from Grossmont Hospital in about two weeks.

The twins had been joined by 1 1/2 inches of tissue at the base of the spine. When the tissue was severed, it was found that there was a slight connection in the spinal channel. The connection, however, did not impede the surgery.

Dr. Thomas O'Connell, who headed the surgeons, said X-rays had disclosed the infants had separate circulations and their hearts beat at different rates, indicating they did not have a common nervous system.

Butte Falls School Gets Federal Money

Washington, D. C. — Senator Richard L. Neuberger of Oregon has advised Butte Falls school district 91 that it has been awarded a tentative entitlement of \$1,762.22 by the office of education of the department of health, education and welfare under public law 874.

The district was certified for an immediate payment of \$1,585.00. A treasury check for that amount has been sent to the district.

The funds are distributed to school districts under the program to provide financial assistance for schools in federally-affected areas.

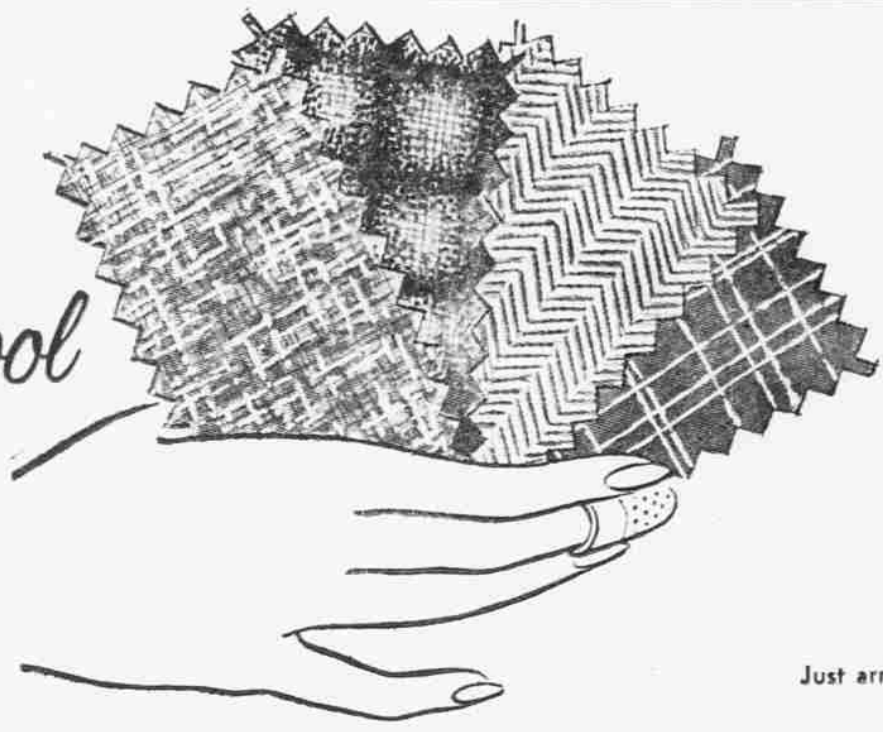
