## Bill Authorizes Tule Lake District

Washington—U.P.—The Senate passed Saturday and sent to the White House a bill authorizing the Secretary of Interior to make a repayment contract for irrigation works with the Tule Lake Irrigation District in California.

The bill clears the way for a contract to guarantee repayment of the federal investment in irrigation features on the Tule Lake Division of the Klamath Reclamation Project. The contract will compromise a dispute over whether revenues from public land leases or water users under the project should pay project costs.
