Heald, who will take over his new position in October, is the subject of an article in the current Newsweek magazine which describes his background and his many activities which take so much time, the magazine says that "Small wonder that his wife, the former Muriel Starcher, seldom sees him." He became president of Armour Institute in 1937 when it was virtually without funds. By 1952, it had merged with Lewis Institute of Technology, and had grown through some \$44 million which Heald had raised for it.
