disease usually calls for an early termination of a pregnancy is generally untrue. In a recent report, Dr. Burwell and his associates said that in the Boston Hospital about the host of the pregnant women found there with heart disease had never known they had any trouble with their heart. They had never been to a doctor. Some 88 per cent had the scars of rheumatic heart disease, and in two-thirds of these cases the trouble was due to the narrowing of the very important mitral valve. In 1 in 10 cases the heart disease was congenital in origin.

The reason why doctors worry about heart trouble in a woman who wants a baby is that pregnancy puts added strain on her body. It increases, by about 40 per cent, the amount of blood that has to be pumped each day. Occasionally, with pregnancy, there may come a flare-up of the old infection of the heart valves. Naturally, the woman with heart disease often needs extra care during her pregnancy. She may get an anemia that has to be corrected.

Occasionally, when the heart fails a bit, the woman has to be bled. Dr. Burwell said that his 300 patients had had 375 pregnancies, with only 3 fatalities. This certainly is a wonderful record. Dr. Burwell rarely advises a therapeutic abortion, or early termination of the pregnancy. Also, he rarely resorts to cesarean section.
