Operations on the Heart

At the recent meeting of the American Medical Association, Dr. B. L. Broffman reported that in the last 57 cases in which he and his group operated on the heart of a man who had suffered a coronary thrombosis they had not lost a single case. This report of success with the Beck operation is interesting for two reasons. One is that it is good to know that something can be done for those persons who, after a heart attack suffer much from pain and disability; and it is good to know that commonly a man who has had a heart attack can come through a severe operation on his heart. This means that many persons with a bad heart need not be too fearful when they are forced to have an operation on gallstones, or cancer.

Naturally, not all the persons who have had a heart attack can stand an operation. Every-thing depends on what we physicians call their "cardiac reserve." To illustrate: Some men, after a coronary thrombosis, can

walk along the street about as rapidly as they did before, without much shortness of breath, and without pain. A less fortunate man, with a poor cardiac reserve, will get short of breath and may get pain on walking slowly, or going up stairs, or even as he sits quietly in his chair at home. He may get distress if he tries to lie flat at night. In such cases, we physicians say that the man's reserve is short and this is far more significant for his future than is the appearance of his electrocardiogram.

Often in these cases a good heart specialist hardly looks at the electrocardiogram. What he wants to know is how far the man can walk without getting pain or distress. The heart is a pump, and one can judge best of its efficiency by finding out how well and comfortably it pumps when put under strain.

Dr. Alvarez hopes his readers will understand that it would be impossible for him to answer requests for information or to attempt to diagnose by mail.

Three Out of Four Houses Have TV

Washington—U.P.—The Census Bureau reported Sunday a February survey showed that three out of four American households have television sets. It estimated that about four per cent of the 48,800,000 households have two sets or more.

The percentage of households with TV sets was a six point gain over a similar survey made in June, 1955, when 67 per cent had sets.

The major gain was in rural areas. Forty-two per cent of these households had sets last year, and now 53 per cent have them. Metropolitan areas gained only from 81 to 84 per cent.
