Czech, Floridan Take Chute Honors

Moscow — (UP) — A Czech parachutist and a Fort Lauderdale, Fla., member of the American "Sky Divers" team captured the first two places in the opening event of the world parachute championship contest Sunday.

Czech chutist Jiri Crivan took opening day honors as he landed only 5 1/2 feet from the center of the target at Tusino Airport, on the outskirts of Moscow.

An estimated crowd of 20,000 spectators looked on as 50 jumpers representing 10 countries attempted to hit the bulls-eye from an altitude of 1,950 feet.

Lewis Sanborn of Fort Lauderdale took second place as he dropped just a little more than eight feet from the center of the target. Jari Pekin, representing the Soviet Union, came within 10 1/2 feet of the mark to take third place in the opening event.

Talent Exchange Program Approved

Moscow — (UP) — American showman Billy Rose said today the Soviet Ministry of Culture has tentatively approved a talent exchange program between Russia and the United States that would involve about 500 entertainers and artists from each country.

Rose said he has been negotiating the exchange program with Soviet officials here the past two weeks. He acted as a private citizen, he said, but with both the knowledge of the U.S. State Department and an endorsement by Rep. Francis E.

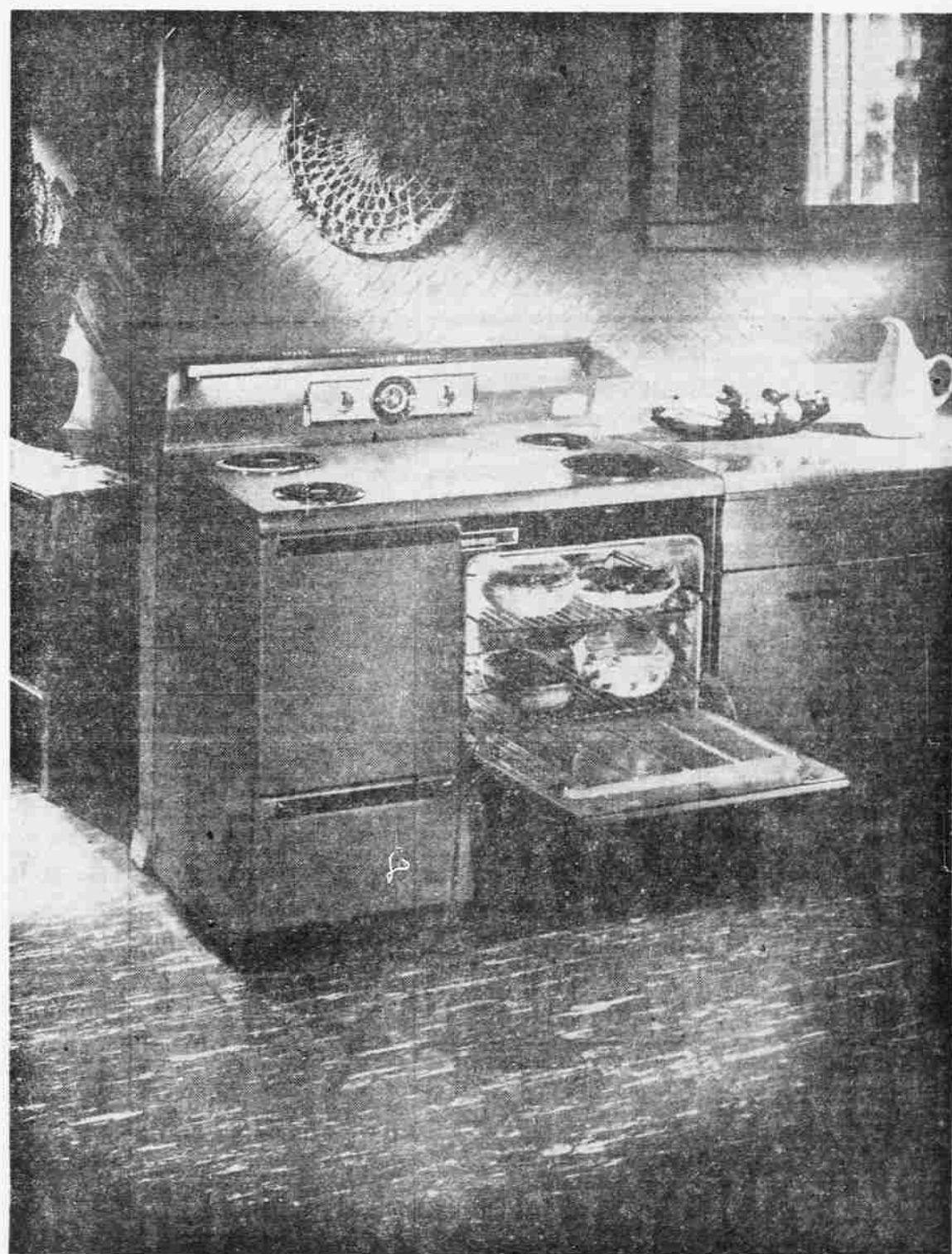
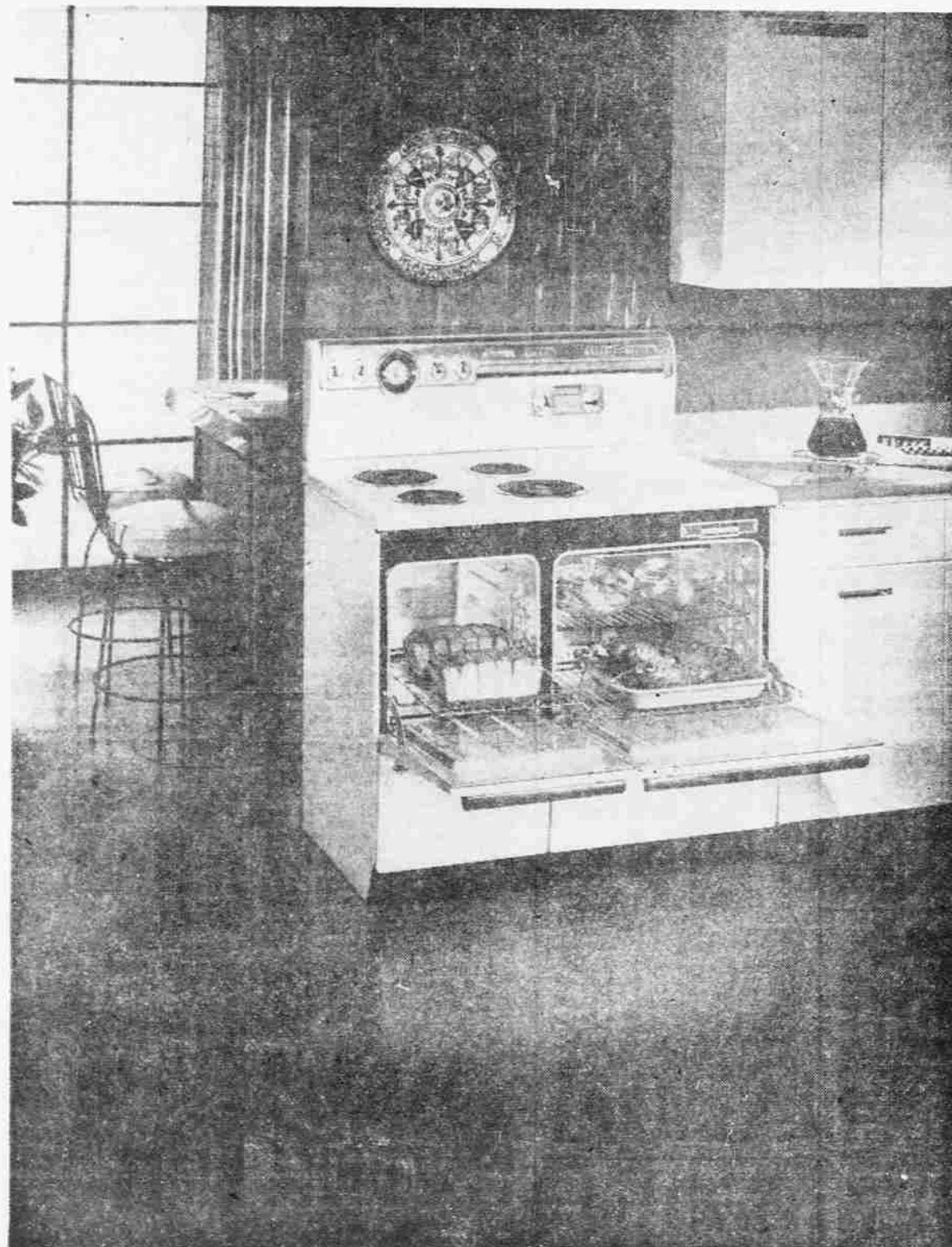
