The funds raised go for the purchase of expensive miracle drugs and medical equipment and supplies which are so badly needed in mission hospital work, both in this country and abroad, those in charge state.

Medford Presbyterian women, along with many other Presbyterian women's groups throughout the country, have chosen an August silver tea as their annual special project for raising funds for this particular need in the medical field. The contributions from the teas and other special projects are sent to national boards of the church for distribution to the neediest places.

Last year Cuba and the Philippines were selected as spots where the funds were most needed, and mobile health units were purchased for use in the rural communities of these countries.

This year it is hoped sufficient money will be raised to aid in the hospital mission work in Africa and Cuba, the committee states. Modernization of supplies (including drugs) and equipment is the great need for nine mission hospitals in Africa. In Cuba the need is for the maintenance of equipment and replenishment of drugs and supplies in the mobile health units which are the only hospital care available to many of the people in the rural communities of that country.
