### Chimpanzees Differ In Character

If one listens to a certain group of psychiatrists, one must believe that all unpleasant traits of character and tendencies to psychosomatic injuries are due to psychic injuries in childhood. According to this group, there is no such thing as heredity. Much against this idea is, of course, the fact well-known to all sensible laymen, that persons are born with different temperaments and abilities. Any intelligent mother knows that these temperaments and abilities are obvious by the time the child is a year or two old.

All persons who have bred dogs or cats know the big differences in the intelligence and temperament of their animals. All those at the great Yerkes laboratory of primate biology at Orange Park, Fla., know that chimpanzees and other apes differ greatly in physical appearance, intelligence, habits, sexuality, and even social graces.

As Dr. Henry W. Nissen reported recently in the American Anthropologist, among the 50 chimpanzees in the Yerkes laboratory, all brought up under the same conditions, some show neurotic tendencies while others do not. Some are thumb-suckers and rockers-back-and-fourth, while others are not. Dr. Nissen tells of two half-sister chimpanzees, Jenny and JoJo, who were born within two months of each other. They were raised together and they now share the same cage. What interests Dr. Nissen is that JoJo has a remarkable talent for using tools, which Jenny entirely lacks. With the help of a stick Jenny can turn on and off light switches, and she can even unscrew a light bulb. None of the other animals have ever done anything like this, although they have watched JoJo at work.

### More Social Intelligence

Jenny has the advantage over JoJo in that she has more social intelligence. She knows when it is wise to compromise or to give in.

All men who work in the zoos know that some animals are good-natured and tame, while others are ill-tempered and even dangerous. Some show a great deal of affection and devotion to

## Constellation of Cepheus Visible in Northern Sky

"There is an exception to every rule," runs an old familiar saying. Even mythology seems to prove this principle. No one has been able to explain just why Cepheus, King of Ethiopia, was placed in the sky. Many of the constellations or star groups have been named in honor of some outstanding hero or heroine. Orion was a mighty hunter; Hercules performed twelve labors that would have discouraged many a man of valor; Perseus killed the terrible Gorgon, Medusa; Ophiuchus stands on a scorpion while holding a serpent in his hands.

Cepheus, King of Ethiopia, was a good king but not outstanding, and only became famous because his wife, Cassiopeia, (dealt with in a recent column) bragged so much that she brought a terrible experience upon her daughter, Andromeda.

In ancient times there were two Ethiopians, one in Asia and another in Africa, so the location of the kingdom ruled over by Cepheus is not definitely known. In addition to this, the stars composing the group named for this king are all rather dim.

### Attracted Attention

However, for some unfathomable reason, Cepheus has attracted attention since the beginning of written records. It was well known to the ancient Egyptians

### Device Inflates Jacket On Contact With Water

Washington—(U.P.)—A new life-saving device has been perfected that automatically inflates a pilot's "Mae West" life jacket upon contact with water.

Planes, official publication of the Aircraft Industries Association, reports that this automatic inflator compares in importance with such standard safety features as the automatic lap belt and automatic parachute release.

Weighing five ounces, it will inflate a jacket within 15 seconds after immersion in water. Formerly, pilots falling unconscious into the water usually drowned because the inflator was not automatic.
