**Decreased Number Of Second Vaccine Shots Disturbing**

Chicago — (U.P.) — Authorities expressed concern today about a decrease in the number of children returning for second Salk vaccine inoculations in Chicago's offensive against a record polio outbreak.

"The responsibility is in the hands of the parents," said Dr. Herman Bundesen, president of the city Board of Health.

Eighteen park district swimming pools and five wading pools were closed Wednesday as the all-out campaign continued to prevent a polio epidemic as the peak of the polio season approached.

**Vaccine Distribution Drops**  
Bundenen and other health officials were disturbed in the drop-off reported in second inoculations at hospitals, clinic and offices of physicians. It was reported the amount of vaccine distributed dropped 18,000 doses Wednesday from 50,000 daily average since the beginning of the polio outbreak. Bundesen blamed lethargic and indifferent parents for the decline.

"The situation may become critical," Bundesen said, "unless parents bring their children in for their second and third shots when they are due."

He also urged parents again to get their children started immediately with the polio inoculations if they already have not done so.

There have been 630 polio cases this year so far and 18 deaths from the disease to make 1956 the worst polio year on record in the city.

**Three Firms Assume Control of Wireless**

Washington — (U.P.) — The Federal Communications Commission Wednesday permitted three publishing firms to assume sole control of Press Wireless, Inc., an international press transmission service.

Under the decision, Press Wireless will be owned by the New York Times, the New York Herald Tribune, and Time, Inc.

The three firms gained control through surrender of 51.5 per cent of Press Wireless stock and \$150,000 in notes by the Chicago Tribune, the San Francisco Chronicle, the Chicago Daily News, the Beacon Herald Publishing Co., Knight Newspapers, Inc., and the Miami Herald.

The previous owners received in return a 55 per cent undivided interest in real estate at Press Wireless's present transmitter site at Hicksville, N. Y. At the same time, the FCC permitted Press Wireless to move its transmitter stations to Centerreach, N. Y.

**Husband's Antics Cause of Divorce**

Santa Monica — (U.P.) — Former movie actress Molly O'Day, 40, was awarded a divorce yesterday from wealthy oil man James McGregor Kenaston, 40, on testimony that their marriage was spoiled because of his unpredictable antics.

"One time he smashed a raw egg on my head at a dinner party," Miss O'Day told a superior court. "Then on Thanksgiving Day I was basting a turkey and he gave me a swift kick and my head landed in the oven with the turkey."

The couple was married in 1932 at Las Vegas, Nev., and separated last Feb. 20.

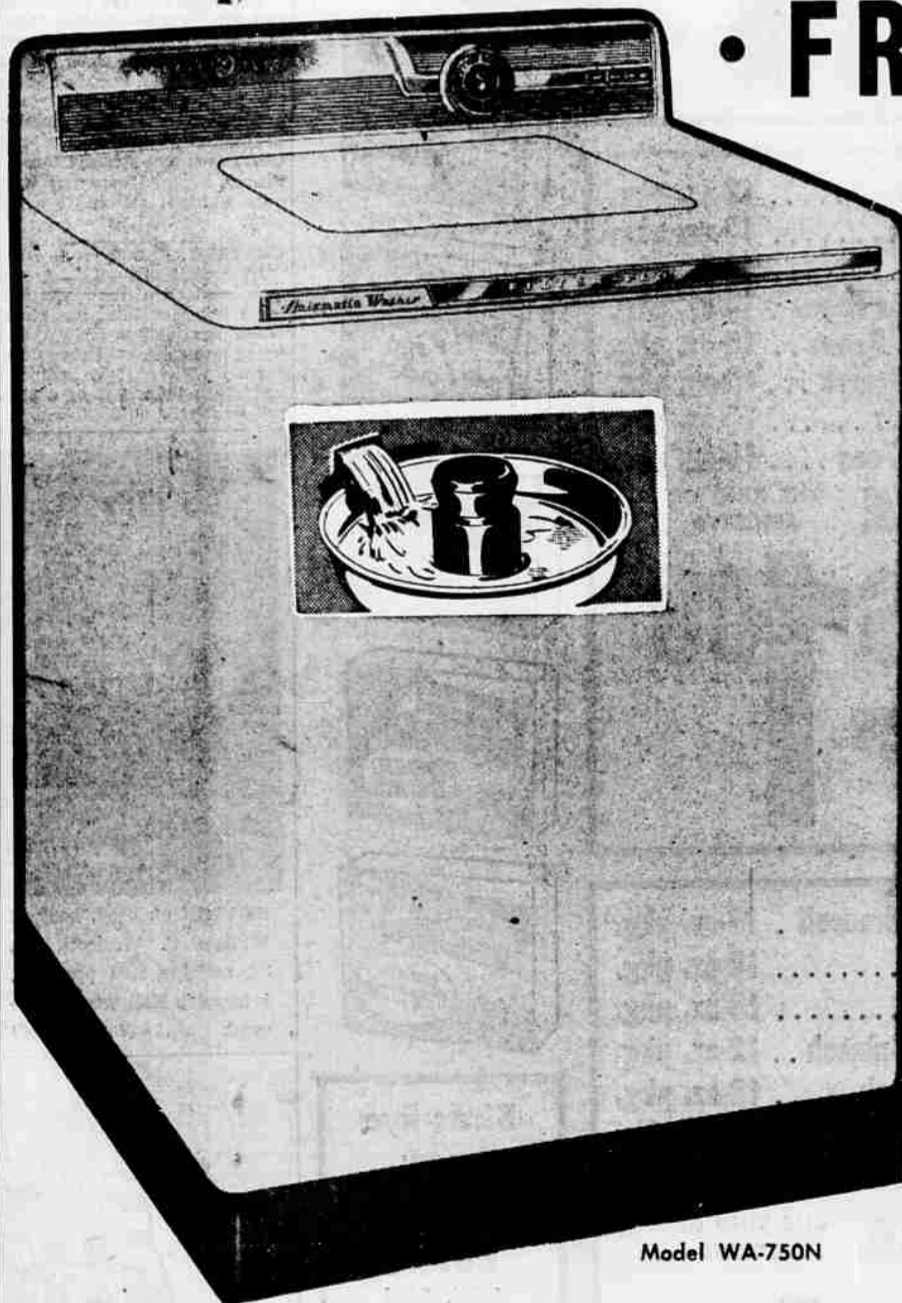

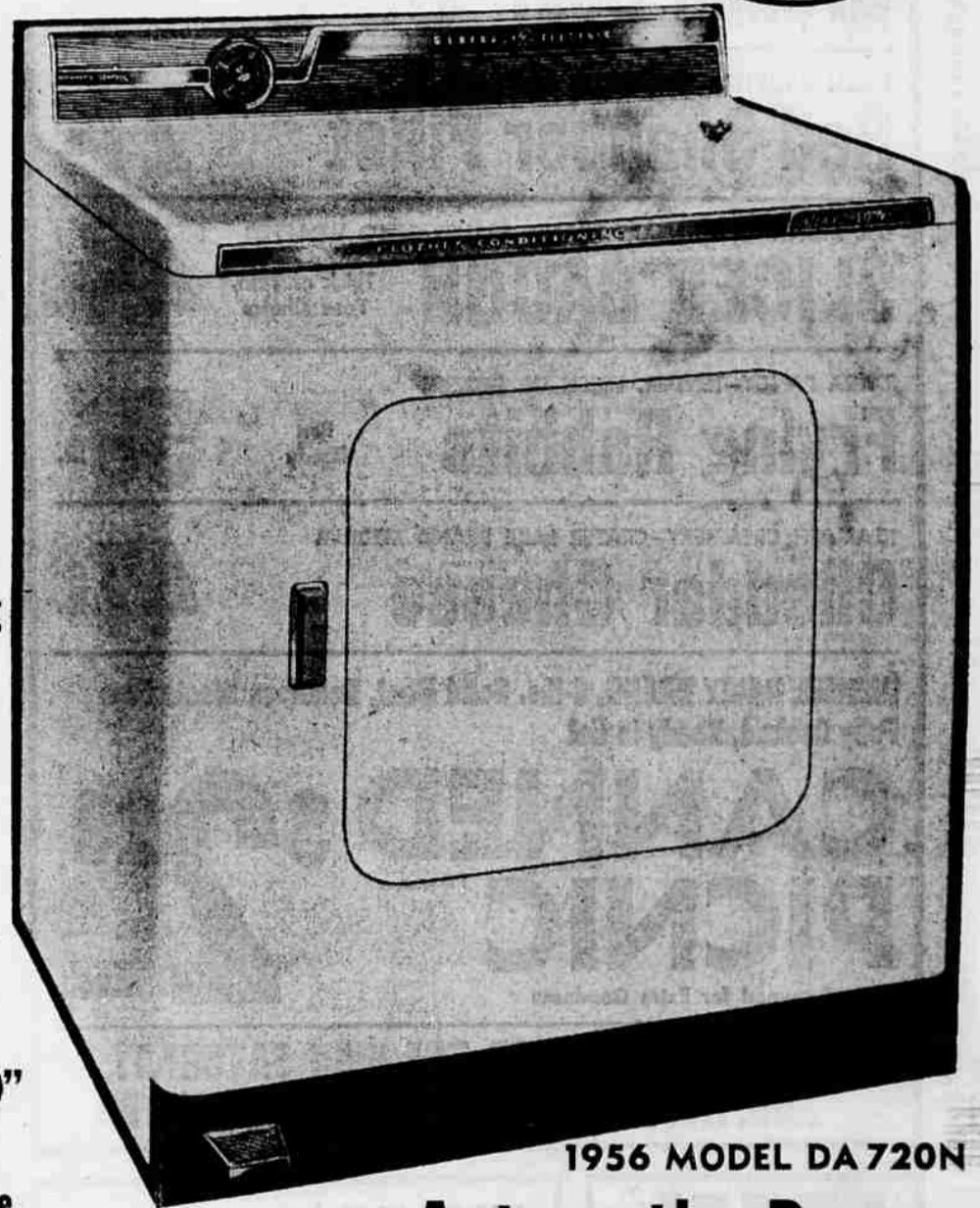
