Vaginal Distresses Due To Trichomonas or Molds

Many women write, much distressed because of a marked vaginal discharge or local irritation or over-sensitiveness. Some know that it is due to the Trichomonas which is a little wiggly single-celled parasite. In most cases these parasites don't cause much trouble, but in a few they produce much irritation. Then the woman is miserable until she can get rid of the infection. In many cases this probably dies out by itself. In some cases the woman gets relief easily by taking each day a few vinegar douches, adding perhaps a tablespoonful of vinegar to a bag of warm water. In other cases the woman gets rid of the irritation by inserting in the vagina a suppository which contains some medicine that kills the parasites. The parasites would probably be killed by cold water alone if it could only reach all of them. The trouble is that they hide perhaps in the neck of the womb or in some of the glands at the entrance to the vagina, or in the outlet tube of the urinary bladder. In a few cases they get into the urinary bladder and then they must be gotten out of there and the vagina at the same time. It doesn't do any good to get them out from one place without at the same time getting them out from the other because, otherwise, the woman can promptly re-infect herself.

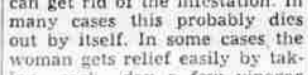
Reinfect Each Other
In some cases the husband and the wife keep reinfecting each

other, back and forth; which means that there is no sense in treating the wife unless the husband is also treated. In a few cases the parasite lives for a time in the husband's prostate gland. I read that now a medicine has been found which when taken by mouth will kill the parasites.

Some women suffer from a vaginal infection with a mold which started growing wild after one of the powerful new antibiotics was given her for a cold or an earache. The drug was so powerful that it killed off the beneficial and helpful bacteria which live normally in the vagina in order to keep bad germs out. When the good germs are killed by an antibiotic, molds take their place, and these can produce a discharge with much soreness and itching. What is unfortunate is that often the woman has to wait for months until the normal germs can grow back again.

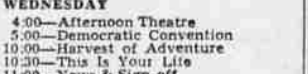
