This makes me suspect a little stroke. If this diagnosis is correct, the ear specialist will find nothing wrong with the ears, and then he will not want to try any treatment of the ears. I see a number of old persons whose home doctor wonders if they have Meniere's disease of the ear, but actually any good ear doctor will say in a minute, "You haven't the typical story of Meniere's disease, and you cannot have it because, after months of distress with buzzing and dizziness your hearing is normal."
