

### Western Electric Phone Installers Go Out on Strike

Portland — (U.P.) — Some 700 telephone installers in Oregon, Washington and Idaho walked off the job today following a stalemate in negotiations for a new contract with Western Electric company in New York.

D. G. Ward, president of the North Pacific local of the Communication Workers of America, said "there will be no Western Electric installers working today in this local, 9290."

Ward said that pickets were not sent out immediately but that they might be before the day is over "depending upon how things shape up." He called it a walkout "in protest of a stalemate in bargaining."

A spokesman for the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company said it was unlikely that telephone service would be affected. "The problem would be whether or not other communications workers would honor the picket lines and stay out," a spokesman said. PT&T said it was "in no way involved" in the dispute.

... fice and switchboard equipment. Negotiations for a new contract were continuing in New York.

Ward said there were about 158 workers in Oregon, with 100 in Portland and others in Salem, Eugene, Roseburg, Medford, Bend and Klamath Falls.

### Sewer, Paving Job Bids Opened Today

Bids were opened at 11 a.m. this morning in city hall on two paving projects and on construction of two sewer projects, according to Vern Thorpe, public works director.

Apparent low bidder for the paving of Ashland ave. from Ninth st. to 11th st. was the Rogue River Paving company of Medford. The bid was for \$11,507. Only other bidder was M. C. Lininger and Sons company of Medford. Their bid was \$11,520.50. Thorpe's estimate was \$11,274. Thorpe said.

M. C. Lininger and Sons company was the apparent low bidder for paving Greenway Circle and Greenway drive. The bid was \$13,555.25. Only other bidder was the Rogue River Paving company with a bid of \$15,092.50. The engineer's estimate was \$12,771.

Apparent low bidder for the construction of the Southeast Medford trunk sewer was the P. S. Lord Construction company of Portland. They submitted a bid of \$124,372.95. The Den Herder Construction company of Lebanon submitted the only other bid. It was for \$269,037.50. Thorpe said the engineer's estimate was \$119,094.

W. H. Conrad Construction company of Medford was the only bidder for an armory trunk sewer. The bid was for \$6,055. The engineer's estimate was \$4,968.
