

YMCA Members, Leaders Return From Camp Session

Seventy-two boys and 15 leaders from Medford, Ashland and Roseburg have returned from the last four weeks of the camping program at the Medford YMCA Diamond Lake camp, according to Robert L. Jones, director and general secretary of the camp. The camp was held from July 22 through August 19.

This was the first year that the three towns have combined in their camping programs. **Camp Highlight** Highlight of the camp was when 24 boys led by Clyde Smith, 64-year-old trip camper, of Ashland, climbed Mt. Thielsen, a 9,300-foot peak adjacent to Diamond Lake. On two separate occasions Smith successfully led these trips up Mt. Thielsen.

This year the youngest camper ever to make the peak as far as the leaders know was Greg Gande, 9-year-old Medford YMCA member.

The newest and best received part of the program was sailing, Jones said. Canoeing and overnight trips to adjacent wildernesses where boys practiced building lean-tos and overnight camping facilities, were also scheduled.

Ceremony Held The installation of a Raggedy ceremony was another attraction during the camp. This ceremony highlights the Christian component of the YMCA program.

The Medford Public library lent about 200 books to the camp which were taken from the "preferred reading list for boys." These books were well used by the boys, according to camp officials, especially on rainy days.

Dean Crumley, a college student from Globe, Ariz., acted as waterfront director along with Bruce Hamilton from the Roseburg school district. Carl Gordon, Medford, from University of Oregon, acted as program director.

More than 50 of the boys from Medford earned their solo campership through the sale of hand-soap, which they procured at the YMCA office.

Last Dynamite Blast Set Off at Dalles

The Dalles — (U.P.) — The last major dynamite blast was set off yesterday afternoon at The Dalles dam. The 20-ton blast displaced 125,000 tons of earth and rock along a natural rock rim at the edge of the Columbia river.

An area 500 feet long was blasted out, permitting water to flow for the first time behind the project structures.

The blast was in preparation for diversion of the Columbia river through a section of the powerhouse, scheduled to take place about Oct. 1. At that time the closure dam will be started.

Footprints were discovered at the base of Chenuis Mountain but it was not known if they were made by the missing boy.

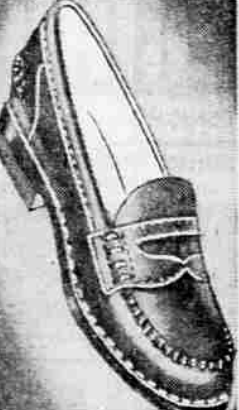
