## Police Department Handles 749 Cases

A total of 749 major and minor offenses were reported to the Medford police department in the month of August. Of these, 659 cases were "cleared," giving the department an 88 per cent "clear" record, according to the monthly report issued by the department.

Major offenses totaled 84 and only 28 cases were cleared. This included 67 cases of larceny and theft involving amounts under \$50, 16 of which were cleared. Miscellaneous offenses numbered 665 and 631 were cleared for 95 per cent record.

Last year during the same month, the department had 632 offenses of all types reported and closed 561 cases for an 89 per cent record. Last August there were 52 major offenses as compared with 84 for this year.

I guess I could have foretold the current do-it-yourself craze if I had just looked at myself. I know how many projects I like to do myself, and I know there must be millions of men as well as women and children who feel the same way.

For those who do not feel there is an inherent knack to create things, there are many books and pamphlets and newspaper features which can act as a guide.

## Children Prove Motivating

I know that one of the great motivating forces in our lives is our children. It might be a good idea to start by making something for the offspring. There are things we can do for them which we wouldn't do for ourselves.

With the simplest tools, a saw, ruler, screwdriver and glue one can make small airplanes, a broom horse or teeter-totter. No toy you can buy, no matter how much you pay for it, will give as much joy.

Another advanced project along the same lines, for a family of several children, is a table and chair set for the nursery. Examine a sample set and you'll see how easy it is to make. After that you can make a knock-neck shelf or a little foot stool.

Before you get into creating any more complicated pieces, the first thing you should build is a solid, steady work bench.

Advice Offered

You can build one from a long four-by-four post with four legs cut to work height, and a table top made from a slab door, which you can buy at any lumber yard.

In fact, they will even pre-cut the material for you. And you can find a detailed drawing of how to solidify the bench.

After that, you can go on to build your own furniture, design your landscaping and eventually, even design and help build your own home. I've done just that.

If it seems like a project beyond your reach, think of your great grandfather who hacked a home right out of the wilderness—and he didn't have half the tools and know-how available today.
