

Two People Cited After Car Mishaps

Two people were cited but no one was injured in two separate car accidents Tuesday, according to state police.

George H. Mann, Portland, was cited for being intoxicated on a public highway at 8:03 p.m., when his car was involved in an accident at the intersection of Highway 99 and Stewart ave. State police said Mann stopped the pickup truck he was driving and another truck, operated by Roy Lee Culthie, 42, Wichita Falls, Tex., struck it from behind.

Dennis Leon Chris, 19, of 500 Fourth st., Phoenix, was cited for making an improper turn after his car was struck by another vehicle driven by James Darrill Benson, 17, of 2665 Crater Lake highway at 9:20 a.m. Tuesday. State police said Chris stopped his car on the east shoulder of Highway 99, waited for a car to pass, then started to turn left when his car was struck by Benson's vehicle, which was traveling north on the highway.

Victim of Accident Reported Improved

Ruth Marie Bean, 16-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Carmen Bean, 907 Mary Jane ave., Ashland, was reported "making good progress" today at Ashland General hospital, where she was taken with critical injuries suffered in a car accident Monday afternoon.

Miss Bean sustained fractures, cuts and shock after the car she was driving went out of control on a curve, struck a power pole and overturned. Her five teen age passengers suffered less serious injuries.

Though physicians have not set all of the broken bones as yet, Mrs. Bean said her daughter is no longer requiring blood plasma. State police officers rushed a supply of blood from Medford to Ashland General hospital Monday night.

Miss Bean received fractures of the right hip, left leg and left wrist.

Butane Gas Tank Starts Riddle Fire

Riddle, Ore. — (U.P.) — A butane gas tank exploded here yesterday, starting fires that destroyed a trailer home, damaged a pickup truck and trailer and severed telephone and telegraph communications between Riddle and outside points for an hour and a half.

Police Chief Ed Alexander said communications were cut when the fire burned utility poles in the vicinity.

The trailer home belonged to Mr. and Mrs. Lavern Landers, officers said. No one was injured in the blast.

Two Portland Youths Killed in Accident

Portland — (U.P.) — Two Portland youths were injured fatally last night when a sports car struck a tree near Blue Lake park.

Police identified the victims as Richard A. Sullivan, 21, and Royce Alnutt, 22. Sullivan was killed outright and Alnutt died from injuries after admission to a local hospital.

Columbus, O. — (U.P.) — Mrs. Hilda McMullen reported to Columbus police that she parked her car near Central High school recently and when she returned she found a six-inch skull and crossbones scratched on the right rear door. On the windshield she found a note reading: "Please do not park in my space or you will find more scratches."

Menninger Accepts Invitation to Speak

Salem — (U.P.) — Dr. William Menninger, an outstanding authority on mental health, has accepted an invitation from Gov. Elmo Smith to appear before the 1957 Oregon Legislature to explain his views on mental health.

Gov. Smith said he conferred with the general secretary of the Menninger foundation of Topeka, Kan., in Portland earlier this week and will ask the legislature to approve a joint resolution inviting Dr. Menninger to address the legislature.

However, Gov. Smith said it had been necessary for him to confirm dates of January 17-18 for Menninger's appearance.

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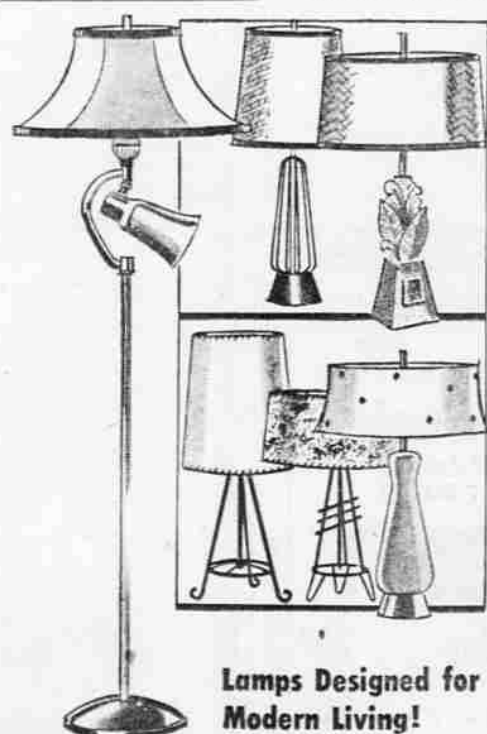


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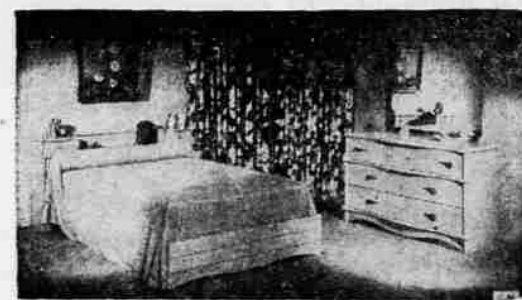
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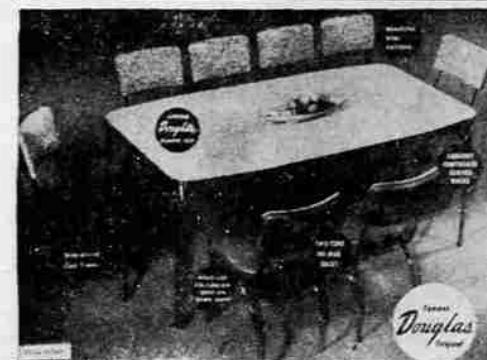
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
