

Neuberger Says Fred Seaton Guilty of 'Misrepresentations'

Portland — Sen. Richard L. Neuberger of Oregon told the West Rod and Gun club in Portland Tuesday night that Secretary of the Interior Fred Seaton had been guilty of "shocking misrepresentations which are totally inconsistent with the ethics expected of a member of the President's cabinet," when Seaton was in Oregon recently to campaign for the election of Douglas McKay to the Senate.

Neuberger said he had special reference to Seaton's statement to the press on Aug. 31 claiming that "the record (in the Al Serena case) has never been submitted to the Justice Department. If the critics are sincere, why don't they give that record to the Justice Department?"

Neuberger said that Seaton's charge was "a deliberate and complete distortion which shows the lengths to which the Republican hierarchy is willing to go in their efforts against Senator Wayne Morse."

Candidates Fair Steering Group To Meet Thursday

Mrs. Kathleen Bash and Mrs. Rosemary Keeney will represent the Republican party, and Mr. and Mrs. Marc Norton and Robert Boyer will represent the Democratic party.

The State Traffic Safety division said today that the latest Oregon figures show 5.1 persons killed in each 100 million miles of travel. The national rate is about 5.9.

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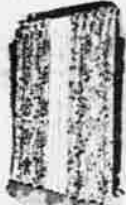
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
