The Medical Roundup

DIVORCEES ANONYMOUS

Some time ago in this column I called attention to a fine organization started a few years ago in Chicago and called Divorcees Anonymous. Their address is P.O. Box 5313, Like Alcoholic Anonymous, this group is made up of persons who know all about a certain life problem because they have been through it. As Vance Packard said in his fine article in the May number of the American Magazine, when a group of these people get together they pour out freely to each other the story of their intimate troubles. They want advice and help from those who have been through what they are experiencing.

Many years ago at the Mayo Clinic, I learned that when I was having great difficulty trying to get a patent to face the fact that to save his life he must quickly let a surgeon remove an eye, or his voice box or a part of his bowel, the simplest way in which I could solve the problem was to go out into the big waiting-room and get someone who had been through the experience to come to my assistance.

This practice was not cheering to my ego, because the minute my new patient found he was talking to someone who had had his disease and been cured of it, he wanted no more of me—all he wanted was to get answers to all his questions from the fellow who had had the personal experience; he wanted his advice and not mine. In his eyes, my handicap was that I knew only by hearsay.

As Mr. Packard says, when in a group of divorcees a woman starts complaining about her husband, the experts about her quickly ask a number of shrewd questions which may show that she, with her childishness or bad temper, was the one who started her husband on a course of drinking or chasing. The members then give the woman good advice, and as in the case of Alcoholics Anonymous, they assign two workers to go to the help of the quarreling couple. In Chicago alone these people have already helped 2500 wives and husbands to get straightened out. They even have "specialists" like the women who, because of their years of experience with "mother-in-law trouble," are experts on what to do and not to do about it.

The only person in Divorcees

Anonymous who has not had a divorce is the prime mover in the organization—Sam Starr—a lawyer who for years has been helping himself out of business by reconciling couples who come to him for legal help in getting a divorce. Mr. Starr became disturbed because when later he ran into people whom he had "freed" he often found them very unhappy. Also, he was distressed over the plight of the thousands of children who had been set adrift when their home was broken up.
