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Hearing Scheduled For Power Company

Salem —(U.P.)—A hearing on Idaho Power Company's petition to the State Hydroelectric Commission to waive certain conditions in connection with its application to build three dams on the Snake river will be held here Nov. 19.

The hearing had originally been scheduled for Sept. 12. The company is seeking waivers and suspension of some commission rules and regulations in connection with construction of Oxbow, Brownlee and Hells Canyon dams.

Commission Secretary Lewis A. Stanley said all protests to the waivers should be filed with him before Nov. 9 and a copy sent to the power company by that date.

Inspections Made On Incoming Grain

Salem —(U.P.)—Incoming grain inspections at Portland, Astoria and Pendleton reached 13,070, 603 bushels during August, the State Department of Agriculture has reported.

Inspection Chief T. Ralph Harry said the August inspections exceeded those of July by more than a million and a half bushels. He said oats and milo were the only incoming grain showing decreased inspections during the month.

August wheat exports totaled 5,707,674 bushels more than two and one half million during the July total, which was an all-time high in wheat exports.

Smith Praises Oregon Drivers

Salem — (U.P.) — Oregon motorists were praised by Gov. Elmo Smith today for their part in making Oregon one of only 17 states which reduced traffic deaths during the three summer months.

Summer traffic showed eight fewer traffic fatalities this year than last year, Gov. Smith said as he reviewed a report of the 1956 slow down and live campaign. The program was launched Memorial Day and ended with the Labor Day weekend.

Two of the three summer holidays, Memorial Day and the Fourth of July, went death-free. Labor day saw four deaths, three below the 1955 Labor Day holiday.

Gov. Smith stressed, however, that despite the summer reduction, the traffic toll for the year to date was still ahead of 1955 by seven deaths.

Segregation Problem Develops in England

Nottingham, England —(U.P.)—White English girls in a textile mill here have refused to work with Negro girls and have forced management to separate workers, it was disclosed Thursday.

Frank Crowson, production manager of the mill, said segregation was the only way of overcoming a shortage of machinists.
