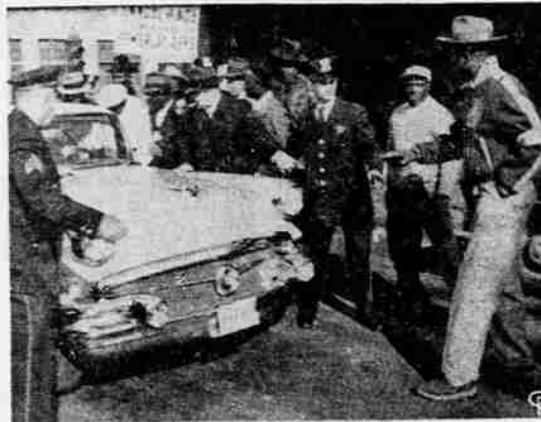


**200 Jailed in Shooting
Of Nicaragua President**

Managua, Nicaragua—(U.P.)—The two sons of President Anastasio Somoza have reported they had jailed 200 members of opposition parties for investigation in the attempted assassination of their father.

President Somoza was reported in satisfactory condition at the American Gorgas Military Hospital at Balboa in the Canal Zone where he underwent delicate neurosurgery lasting four hours Sunday for removal of the bullets that almost cost his life.

His two sons—Luis, 34, president of Congress, and Col. Anastasio Jr., 32, head of the national guard, who appear to be handling the country's day-to-day affairs now—said they did not rule out the possibility of a plot against Somoza.

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**Stockholm Officer
Admits to Failure**

New York—(U.P.)—The officer in charge of the liner Stockholm the night it rammed and sank the Andrea Doria admitted yesterday that he failed to make a radar calculation of the Italian liner's speed as it approached him in a fog bank.

Under cross examination at a pre-trial hearing, Third Mate Ernest Carstens-Johansen testified that he plotted the Andrea Doria's relative course according to radar blips but did not make the time notations necessary for a calculation of its speed.

The 26-year-old officer said he was aware that the instruction book for the use of radar equipment aboard the Swedish-American liner required a time notation for each charting of position of an approaching vessel but that he had relied on "visual calculation" to get the Andrea Doria's approximate speed.

**Israel Disputes
Machine Gun Charge**

Jerusalem, (Israel Sector)—(U.P.)—Jordan reported Monday that a soldier "ran amok" and fired a machinegun into an Israeli crowd, killing three persons and wounding 12, but Israel disputed the charges.

An Israeli source said evidence submitted by investigators showed the machinegun fire which mowed down delegates to an archeological congress came from "more than a single Jordanian soldier."

They said Jordan could hardly claim all the soldiers participating in the affray were "taken by madness."

**President Considers
Self Physically Fit**

Washington—(U.P.)—President Eisenhower, on the first anniversary of the heart attack he suffered a year ago, considers himself healthy and vigorous for a man of his age.

At 65—he'll be 66 on Oct. 14—Mr. Eisenhower harbors no thoughts of possible recurrence of either heart trouble or ileitis, the intestinal ailment for which he underwent an operation last June 9, persons closest to him report.

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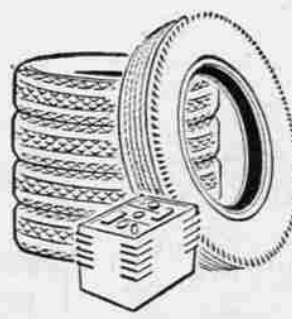
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
