What Can the Retired Woman Do?
Mrs. Isabel B. LaFollette, wife of the former Governor of Wisconsin, said recently that she has been organizing Women's Exchange Services to help retired women to work and be useful and earn money.

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
As Mrs. LaFollette says, there is such tremendous need for help in these fields, but the average woman prefers to be useless and lonely and poor. Why? Because she thinks these jobs are beneath her. They are not beneath anyone. I know business women who have had a terrible time finding a reliable woman to take over the job of running the home, and I know lonely women who have gone into a home where there was ample means, and have found comfort, usefulness, affluence, and sometimes a family to love and take care of.

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
Mrs. LaFollette advised retired women to (1) Decide what values are most important to you; (2) Do not break old ties too suddenly; (3) Be cautious about changing climates; (4) Limit physical activities; (5) Decide whether it is worthwhile to keep up the old home.

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
One of the greatest forward steps ever taken in medicine must soon be taken. It will be marked by the development of methods for the recognition of carriers of the many hereditary diseases. A carrier is a man (or woman) who carries more or less latent and hidden a tendency to a disease such as diabetes, gout, epilepsy or schizophrenia (mental disease). In many cases the disease shows up when the person is 40 or 50.

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
The great need for recognizing carriers is that if the man who carries diabetes happens to marry a woman who carries the same tendency to disease, a high percentage of their children are likely to get it. If he were lucky enough to marry a woman with no diabetes in her stock their children might escape.

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
Fine, thoughtful and enlightened persons with, let us say, epilepsy in their family are now coming in to say, "I worry about my children getting the disease. Johnnie and Joanie are, I think, free of it because the are good, happy and friendly children, but Fred here has always had his grandfather's terrible temper; he is difficult and 'ornery' and he has always had awful nightmares. Is there any test that will tell us 'at he has a tendency to epilepsy'?"

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
I then send the young man for an electroencephalogram—a record of the tiny electric currents constantly being formed in the brain—and back perhaps comes the report "typical epileptic spikes and seizure activity."

What Can the Retired Woman Do?
Then the mother may say, "That settles it. I have been much against Fred's marrying the girl next door because I have heard that her brother, in a V.A. hospital, has from time to time some sort of a fit." And the mother is so right. If the girl should be a carrier of epilepsy some of their children would almost certainly be epileptics.

Portland Policeman Killed in Accident
