

The applicant shall also submit a statement of the estimated value of the property and a brief, but accurate and pertinent description of the property of the applicant assessed for the cost of said facility. At the time of filing the same, the applicant shall tender and pay an amount equal to one-twentieth of the total amount assessed to the property for which the application is made. When such application is so filed and the amount so tendered is paid to the assessment lien shall be docketed, payable, enforced and collected in the same manner, and shall bear the same rate of interest, as provided in the Bancroft Bonding

of the City of Medford, Oregon, from the proceeds of the bonds to be issued from the date of issue, and to contain such call features and provisions and due dates and interest payment dates, as the City Council may deem desirable. Subject to the laws of the State of Oregon. The expenses of issuing and selling said bonds may be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of said bonds. The City Council hereby authorized to levy taxes upon the taxable property within the City of Medford, in addition to all other taxes, in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the bonds hereby
