Washington—The thumping of the Eskimo drum, mainstay of Arctic entertainment for centuries, may soon be swallowed up in the glare of radio and jukebox.

As civilization creeps across the frozen north—along, for example, the Distant Early Warning radar line now being built by the American and Canadian governments—more and more Eskimos are taking up white men's jobs and, with them, white men's ways. Although the gregarious, pleasure-loving Eskimos still gather at the slightest excuse for a drum-and-dance feast, the art of drumming is no longer being pursued by the younger generation.

Teen-age Eskimos, given the chance, make ardent jukebox jitters. They still dance with their elders, however, and there lies the hope of maintaining one of their people's most colorful traditions.

## New Polio Cases Drop; Season Passes Peak

Washington—(U.P.)—New polio cases dropped sharply again last week, confirming earlier evidence that the 1956 season has passed its peak.

The Public Health Service said Thursday that 655 new cases were reported in the nation last week compared to 765 for the previous week. Except for one brief spurt, the weekly toll has been declining steadily since August.

The 655 new cases last week compared with 1,259 for the comparable week of 1955. So far this year there have been 12,153 cases, sharply below the 23,010 at this time last year.
