A Throw-Away Artificial Kidney

Every so often now, when someone's kidneys fail and quit working the person may perhaps be aided over and saved with the help of an artificial kidney. The person's blood goes through the "kidney"—usually a big piece of apparatus set up near his bed—and then back into his veins. The kidney takes out of his blood bad waste products which, if left in his body, would soon kill him.

Now come Dr. W. J. Kolff, Bruno Watchinger and Victor Vertes, of the Cleveland Foundation, who have designed a small but efficient "kidney" that goes in a sealed and sterile fruit can. The kidney can be bought all ready to use, and when the patient is tired over, the can is thrown away.

Traffic Violators

Drs. H. W. Case, Ismar Reiter, E. A. Feblowitz, and R. G. Stewart, of Los Angeles, have just reported a study of 300 habitual traffic violators which satisfied them that these persons for the most part are "normal" except for the fact that one in 3 resented the police, 22 per cent were perhaps too aggressive and 2 per cent were hostile. This still leaves us without much knowledge of why these particular persons were frequently violating traffic regulations.

Moscow Appeals for End of 'Hooliganism'

London — (U.P.) — Soviet officials have appealed to Russian parents to help stop Moscow-style juvenile delinquency — "hooliganism."

Radio Moscow reported Sunday that Deputy Prosecutor Gen. Vladimir Alexandrovich Boldyrev urged more than 2,000 persons at a meeting in Moscow's Hall of Columns to help his office and the police to maintain public order against "hooliganism."

Cotton Crop Figured At 13,268,000 Bales

Washington — (U.P.) — The Agriculture Department today estimated a 13,268,000 bale cotton crop will be produced this year.

Today's estimate, based on Oct. 1 crop conditions, compares with output last year of 14,721,000 bales of cotton and 10-year average production of 13,098,000 bales.

This year's prospective crop, added to a carryover of 14.1 million bales, will meet consumption demands, both domestic and foreign, for more than two years.

Klamath Infant Scalded To Death

Klamath Falls — (U.P.) — A one-month-old baby girl was scalded to death in her trailer home on the outskirts of Klamath Falls yesterday when a three-year-old neighbor boy put the infant into the bathtub and turned scalding hot water on the tiny child.

Police Identified the victim as Debora Lee Nieminen, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Nieminen. The father is in the Navy, police said.

Police withheld the name of the boy but said he had taken the child's clothing off and put her into the tub, apparently planning to give the baby a bath.
