London—(U.P.)—Prime Minister Anthony Eden has been confined in a hospital since Friday because of a "feverish chill" it was announced Saturday.

A statement from 10 Downing st., the prime minister's official residence, said Eden developed the chill while visiting his wife Friday at the University College hospital where she is undergoing a dental checkup.

It said doctors advised Eden to remain in the hospital, but that the fever is subsiding and the prime minister should be able to resume work in a day or two.
