Temperatures Freeze In Most of Midwest

Freezing temperatures covered a wide section of the Midwest early today, but general warming was occurring behind the cool air mass that was blanketing the eastern portion of the nation.

Meanwhile, the U. S. Weather Bureau said a severe drought was prevailing over the central and southwestern portions of the nation, "intensified by continued mostly dry sunny weather and above-normal warmth."

Clear skies aided the mercury in dropping to near or below the freezing mark over most of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan and the northern portions of Illinois and Indiana. Outside the freezing temperature zone, readings in the area covered by the cool Canadian air were generally in the 40s.

Obstacle Removed For Polish 'Tito'

London — (U.P.) — Experts on affairs behind the Iron Curtain said today the resignation of Polish Vice Premier Hilary Minc eased the way for Poland's "Tito" to enter the government once again — another result of the Poznan uprising.

The experts believed Minc's resignation removed the last obstacle to re-entry of Wladislaw Gomulka into the Communist Party's politburo. Gomulka represents the liberal wing of the Polish Communists, while Minc was one of the party's last old Stalinists.

Minc, 47, and Jewish, resigned as vice premier and first deputy chairman of the council of ministers Tuesday because of "prolonged illness." His resignation followed by hours the dismissal of three vice ministers in the machine industry, raising to five the total number dismissed in a 10-day period.

The major government shake-up was believed a direct result of the Poznan riot trials which brought into the open unprecedented attacks on the manner in which the Communist regime treated Polish workers.

Water Resources Group Prepares for 2 Agency Hearings

Rogue River — The Rogue Basin Flood Control and Water Resources association last night formulated a statement which will be presented at two public hearings this month conducted by federal agencies.

The directors present agreed on a statement of facts. The statement also outlined the history of the association and the groups' aims toward eventual flood control in the Rogue river basin.

The association recommended that citizens prepare statements giving their views on why flood control is important in the area. One hearing will be held Friday, Oct. 19, in the federal court room in the Medford post office building by the interior and public works committees on proposed flood control on the river.

The other hearing will be held in Frantz Pass Oct. 25 in the Josephine county library auditorium by the Army corps of engineers. The association urged residents of the valley to prepare written statements to present at the hearings.

Oral statements will be heard at the hearings, the association said, and written statements will be forwarded to Washington, D.C.

The association will hold its next meeting in the Grange hall in Rogue River starting at 8 p.m., Tuesday, Oct. 16.

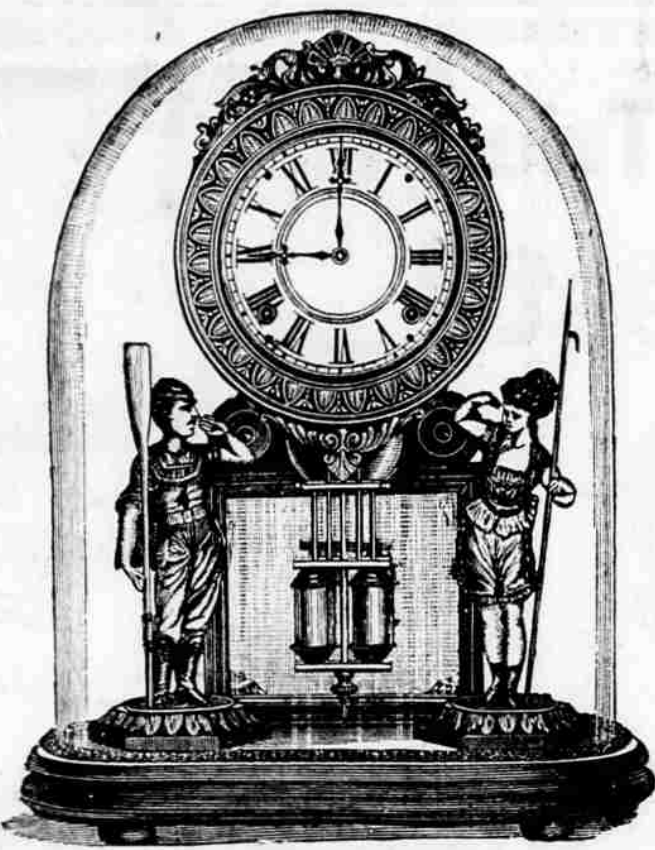
