

# Decision Upholding Legality of Hells Canyon Aired by Politicians

Decision by the U. S. Court of Appeals in upholding legality of Idaho Power company's license for construction of a three-dam development of the Hells canyon site on the Snake river drew political attention from both sides in Oregon today.

Douglas McKay, who is opposing Sen. Wayne L. Morse for the senate, charged that Morse "defied the orderly processes of law for his own selfish political advantage" and sold Adlai Stevenson a "shoddy bill of goods" about Hells Canyon.

"Not End of Fight"  
Morse termed the court action "not the end of the fight to preserve this magnificent multiple purpose site for full development."

McKay said "The court's decision should make it clear to the people of Oregon, once and for all, that the Hells Canyon matter was decided in accordance with the law, and that Morse's intemperate speeches are merely defiance of the orderly processes of the law for his own selfish political advantage."

Morse said "the case is going to the Supreme Court . . . and the people can save Hells Canyon . . . by electing the Stevenson-Kefauver ticket and a Democratic congress."

Sen. Richard L. Neuberger declared "this is not the end of the great struggle to prevent the surrender of priceless power and flood control resources of the Columbia Basin to private monopoly."

# Linn County Escapee To Fight Extradition

Albany—(U.P.)—James Arthur Patton, one of a quartet of men who broke out of the Linn county jail here last month, will fight extradition from California where he was captured.

Linn County Sheriff George Miller said he learned yesterday that Patton, facing a life sentence when he fled jail, has refused to waive extradition proceedings.

Patton was captured at Manhattan Beach, Calif., last Thursday. Only one of the four escapees is still at large.

Ernest Loring Gibson was apprehended in Coos Bay last Friday and Dan C. Ott, a third fugitive, was found drowned in the Willamette river near Salem.

# VA Training Guide Help To Employees

Washington—(U.P.)—The Veterans Administration has issued a training guide to help its 177,000 employees do a better job of meeting the public face-to-face, by telephone or by letter.

Some of the tips it offers:  
Face-to-face: "Recognize a visitor promptly. If you can't avoid a delay, explain it right away. Be a good listener."  
By telephone: "Greet the caller pleasantly. Give information willingly. Hang up the receiver gently."  
By letter: "Don't repeat what is said in a letter you receive. Don't try to impress your reader with big words and long involved sentences."

# Revolution Urged By Chiang Kai-shek

Taipei, Formosa—(U.P.)—Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek called upon mainland Chinese today to overthrow the Peiping Communist government—almost the last hope of the men who fled to Formosa on Dec. 7, 1949.

Political and military observers agreed that a revolution against the Chinese Reds would signal a counterattack by the powerful Nationalist armies to regain the mainland. But there was no estimate when and if it would occur.

An air of semi-permanency

has settled upon Formosa in the meantime. The Nationalists are determined to return to China but the people have been told they must wait the right moment—a moment that now seems far away.

Chiang made the appeal in a "double tenth" address commemorating the founding of Nationalist China 45 years ago on the tenth day of the tenth month by Dr. Sun Yat-Sen.
