**Squadrons Grounded After Crash of Jet**

Minneapolis — (U.P.) — All reserve and air defense squadrons were ordered grounded at Wohl-Chamberlain field today pending an investigation into the crash of a F89 Scorpion jet which killed one man and critically injured the pilot.

The accident was one of a series at the airport which has taken 15 lives since last June. Killed was Radar Observer Lt. Joe E. Ward, 29, Minneapolis. The pilot, Lt. Robert P. Couch, 26, St. Paul, was taken to the Veterans' hospital here in critical condition.
