They came to Portland in 1907 from Pittsburgh, Pa., where Mr. Bishop was in the produce business. In Portland he was in the grocery business and operated a garage there for several years.

Ashland — Mrs. Arthur S. Taylor, died last Sunday morning at her home in Ashland following an unexpected heart attack. During the past week she had suffered several light attacks.

Blanche Landrith was born in Coos county. Her grandfather, Cyrus Landrith, crossed the plains to Oregon in 1852. After attending Oregon State college she taught for several years. She was married to Arthur S. Taylor at Coos Bay June 4, 1921.

Two children, Nathan and Lucy Katherine, preceded her in death. Mrs. Taylor is survived by her husband and one daughter, Georgia Blanche.

Mrs. Taylor was a longtime member of the Bend chapter, Order of Eastern Star. She also was a member of the American Legion auxiliary and was active in the Southern Oregon Pioneer society. She was a lifelong member of the Presbyterian church.

The Taylors came to Ashland more than 30 years ago when Dr. Taylor accepted a position on the college faculty.

Funeral services were held Tuesday in Litwiller's Mount View chapel with the Rev. B. J. Holland officiating. Final rites were in the Coos River cemetery.
