

Maclaren School Bid Tops Available Fund

Salem —(U.P.)—Jurn and Sons, Portland, was low of nine bids opened yesterday for construction of a 100-bed dormitory at Maclaren school for boys near Woodburn.

Jurn and Sons bid \$399,900, followed by Beede construction company, Portland, \$399,980 and Richard Martin company, Oswego, \$421,229.

However, the Jurn bid was approximately \$76,000 above the \$323,900 available for basic construction. The legislature appropriated \$412,000 for the project which included \$52,000 for furnishings. Architects fees must also come out of construction money.

Board of control Secretary William Ryan said the board would decide within the next 30 days if additional money can be raised for the project.

Plymouth Design Ahead of Schedule

Detroit — (U.P.) — Plymouth introduced today its 1957 cars featuring soaring tail fins and parking-turn signal lights located parallel to the headlamps to give a dual headlight effect.

The more powerful and restyled cars ride on a longer wheelbase but sedans, hardtops and convertibles actually are one-fifth of an inch shorter in overall length.

Plymouth President J. P. Mansfield said the '57 cars, which go on display in dealer showrooms across the country next Tuesday, are three years ahead of schedule in design.

"The car we are about to introduce has the style and features of the car we thought, only a few years ago, as possible for about 1960," he said. "We have moved faster than we had hoped. The public has shown an eagerness to accept dramatic change."

While the length has changed little, the new Plymouths are as much as five inches lower. Headlamps, parking lights and turn signals are housed in fender hoods blending into a huge, restyled grille.

Mercury Offers 'Projectile' Style


Detroit — (U.P.) — Mercury unveiled today its 1957 cars with push-button transmission and "projectile" stylings based on its experimental Turnpike Cruiser.

The most distinguishing features of the new models are the angles rear fender fins set off by long, concave projectile-like impressions. The front end is enhanced by forward-thrust fender hoods protruding over a concave grille with horizontal chrome strips.

F. C. Reith, Ford Motor Co. vice president and Mercury general manager, said the 1957 cars "represent one of the most extensive model changes" in automotive history.

The new Mercury's "dream car" styling is based on the XM-Turnpike Cruiser — an experimental model — which was introduced last January and has won nationwide approval on its coast-to-coast tour this year," he said.

The 1957 Mercury is four inches wider, five inches longer and three inches lower than its 1956 counterpart. Total glass area has been increased by 700 square inches.
